COACHING COMMITTEE:

The three preseason coaching clinics were a success. We will be using a technical trainer for U8 (player evaluations and skills clinic), for U6 Striker All Stars and Striker player evaluations.

TOPSOCCER:

8 players are enrolled currently. Starts Sunday April 15, 2012. Volunteers to meet at 3:30. Committee meeting will be held this Saturday. We still need buddies. Shirts will be in Friday and we plan on re-using medals that were found – just replacing the back.
