



## GENERAL RULES

- 3v3 summer league will consist of 5 consecutive weeks of play. Dates will consist of June 9<sup>th</sup> thru July 11<sup>th</sup>. Teams will play 2 games per week, with a tournament in week 5.
- **Registration is \$250 per team.**
- Team and individual registration is available. If GASC provides you with a team your registration cost will be \$250 divided by amount of available players(3-6).
- You can have all girls/boys on a team, but you will play in a coed league.
- Teams are allowed a maximum of six (6) players on the roster. Guest players or switching of players from one team to another is not allowed (**NO EXCEPTIONS**).
- Teams may have players from different age groups. If this is the case then you must register your team in the league that the oldest player falls under.
- Waiver forms during registration **must** filled out by all players/parents in order to be eligible to play.
- All teams must have a coach for registration. A coach by description is anyone over the age of 18.
- You will not have a scheduled practice time for this league. **Practice is not mandatory.**

## FIELDS

- Fields will be **25 yards wide by 35 yards long** with a mid-field line.
- There will be a goal box directly in front of the goal 8 feet from the goal line and 12 feet wide. No player may touch the ball within the goal box area, however players may move within the goal box area.

## RULES OF PLAY

- Ball size: **U8** – Size 3  
**U10** – Size 4  
**U12 and up** – Size 5

Either team will provide a game ball per required league size.

- No off sides.
- No slide tackling.
- No throw-ins. The ball must be kicked in from the sideline.
- Goal kicks may be taken from any point on the end line.
- With the exception of corner and penalty kicks, all free kicks are indirect kicks. A five yard space must be given on all free kicks at the referee's discretion.
- Penalty kicks are awarded if in the opinion of the referee, a scoring opportunity was denied by the infraction in the attacking half of the field. Penalty kicks are taken from the middle of the mid-field line with all players behind the mid-field line. A goal may be scored directly from a penalty kick. If a goal is not scored, the defending team is awarded a goal kick. Penalty kicks are not live balls.
- Scoring –goals can be scored from anywhere on the offensive half of the field of play. A goal may be scored directly from a penalty kick and corner kick
- Kick-off to start each half of play or restart play after a score. The kick-off may be played in any direction. A goal may not be scored directly from a kick-off.
- Goal box area violation – if a defender touches the ball in their defensive goal box area, a goal is awarded to the offensive team. If the offensive team touches the ball in the offensive goal box area, a goal kick is awarded to the defensive team. Any part of the ball or player's body on the line is considered in the box. If the ball comes to a complete stop within the goal box area, a goal kick is awarded regardless of which team touched it last.
- Teams should wear matching uniforms (color) and must wear standard soccer equipment such as shin guards and cleats. If two teams have the same colored shirt, the listed home team must wear pennies.
- **No jewelry of any type.** Soft (non-metallic) sweatbands, rubber bands, scrunchies are allowed. No metal hair clips. Note: if a player must keep jewelry in (i.e. newly pierced ears), it must be covered with a Band-Aid or tape.

- Teams play with 3 field players, no goalies.
- Games will consist of two(2) – 20 minute halves with a three(3) minute half time. No overtime, games may end in a tie.
- Teams may sub players at any time.
- **Referees' decisions are final, no protests allowed.**

#### **SCORING SYSTEM**

Win = 3 points

Tie = 1 point

Loss = 0 points

#### **WINNERS OF EACH AGE BRACKET**

- ALL participants in the league will receive a participant's 3v3 league t-shirt.
- **Only** the top 3 teams of each age bracket will receive medals.
- Winners are determined by total amount of points laid out in the scoring system above. In the event that two teams are tied. Winners will be decided in this order:
  1. Head-to-head results between tied teams. Go directly to 2nd tie-breaker.
  2. Goal differential
  3. Goals scored
  4. Least goals allowed
