League Fees:

1. \$105 for the season including 10 games.
2. Fees will remain the same for the fourth season in a row.
3. Refunds: no refund policy in effect. Special exceptions may be considered. See website...

Fall Season Schedule

1. September 10 through November 12.
2. 10 game season, built in 3 Rain Dates: November 19, December 3 & 10. No games on weekend after Thanksgiving.
3. Format: D1 – play every team twice with highest point to determine the winner.
4. Format D2: 10 teams – round robin with post season bracket, however, highest points determines the divisional winner.
5. First tie-breaker will continue to be head to head.

Fields

1. Fellowship, GJCC, and 2 fields at Metro Soccer Complex (Dell).
2. Freedom is available as a back-up field starting in October.
3. The third field at Dell can be available as a back-up, as well.
4. Rain out text messages are available. See website (Under Fields tab) for instructions on how to sign up.

Referees

1. Referee assignor – Randy Pavlovich.
2. We hope you all have noticed that the overall quality of our officials has improved lately.

Disciplinary Committee (Michael Paris)

1. Language Policy – continue to discourage players using foul or abusive language. Currently enacted rules are per the FIFA laws of the game. Language may be considered foul or abusive by the referee if it is Personal (directed at another player) public (loud enough to be heard on the sidelines or adjacent field) or provocative (meant to get another player involved in the

argument). There is no zero tolerance policy, instead the FIFA laws will be enforced by the referee per his/her discretion.

2. Referee abuse & respect – yellow cards for dissent – captain’s armbands should be worn and captains should be the only ones to address the referees (in a calm and respectful manner). Referees are encouraged to give cards for dissent.
3. If a player receives a red card in a match, he/she is required to sit out the next game regardless of being notified by the DC. We sometimes do not get referee reports from make-up games before the next scheduled matches. An additional game suspension will be enforced for players who do not sit out as required in their next match after receiving a red card.
4. Points accumulate per the posted League rules. After 4 points a one game suspension will be enforced.
5. Keep the team in the technical area and subs from midfield. If the field is not lined with a technical area, please give a 10 yard buffer from midfield for subs.
6. Captains Reports – Reports are REQUIRED when cards are issued in your match. Please reply by Tuesday each week.
7. Email MTSAreports@williamsonn.com to reach the discipline committee – Jon Norris (Celtic & Nashville Celtic), Freddy Ramirez (Villa), J, Casey, Bret, & Michael Paris.
8. Other members on the DC are welcomed and needed since we lost a few members recently.

Rules & Regulations

1. As a reminder the subbing rules were updated last season. If a team subs on their own throw-in and the other team also has players in the area ready to sub, then both teams may sub.
2. Printed rosters with jersey #s, IDs at check-in 20 mins before game time.
3. OR – Team may simply present photo roster (with jersey #s included) to the referee in order to check in the players on the team.
4. Uniforms – All players must have a unique jersey number – STATE MANDATED. The jersey numbers should be written on the team roster before it is given to the referees.
5. Over 30 – only 2 players from age 27 to 30 are permitted on each team. Rosters are checked at the beginning of the season (the ages listed on the TSSA roster are never correct and can’t be changed).
6. Guest Player Policy: Guest Players are permitted in any MTSA match as long as it is agreed to in advance by both team captains. A guest player must bring a printed copy of his regular team’s roster and give it to the referee. Each team is only permitted to use guest players in two games during the season. The number of guest players used is at the opposing team’s discretion.
7. Slide Tackling rules will remain the same as last season. Over 30 D2, there will be no slide tackling. The two teams must discuss if sliding tackling will be allowed for D1 matches. If one team disagrees or if it is not discussed, then slide tackling will not be allowed. It is the captain’s responsibility to address this issue with the referees at game time.
