- The club may offer an F-License course if there is enough interest from recreation coaches who would like to be eligible to coach a travel team

### **Travel Report**

- If there is a pre-play, the times may change for other games scheduled on that day, so coaches are asked to check the times on the schedule each week
- The best day to schedule a pre-play will be Saturdays and should be scheduled with Gary well in advance to make sure there will be a field and referees available, especially for the first two weekends in November when school is out for a week

- Make sure the Board is aware of any potential problems with the children or parents as soon as a situation arises

## **MOSA Report**

- There are 6000 referees in NJ so there should be enough for every game coaches were asked to make sure they bring the correct breakdown of referee fees for the game, which is available at the MOSA website
- The flight coordinator can not post forfeits or corrections and protests must go through the MOSA secretary, Jess Yeager
- If a game needs to be made up after starting, the time of the halves played must be equal
- Small-sided teams must have the players and their parents sit on the same side of the field
