The Foxcroft facility is top class and includes an indoor gym, four outdoor soccer fields, an Olympic size swimming pool, air conditioned dorms, and excellent dining facilities.

Players will receive instruction from the Loudoun Soccer Technical and Coaching staff. We will also be bringing in guest clinicians for both sessions. The focus will be on technical skill development, tactical awareness, goal scoring, possession with a purpose, and functional play.

In addition to our guest Clinicians, for our College Showcase, we will be bringing in current College Coaches. The College Coaches will be available to the players as resources throughout the camp. In addition, College Coaches will be conducting seminars for players.
