This form must be read and agreed to by each administrator. Please sign either this form and return it to the appropriate CDAA Sport Director or sign a "team" signature document for all players, parents and coaches. In either case, please keep a copy of this document for your reference.

I pledge to exemplify the highest moral character, behavior, and leadership while a member of CDAA board by following this Administrators Code of Conduct:

- I will apply CDAA policies and rules equitably at all times.
- I will treat all players, coaches, officials, administrators and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, sex, or ability.
- · I will support a player philosophy which promotes enjoyable, fair and safe participation for youth of all levels of ability.
- I will work within the organizational structure defined in the CDAA by-laws.
- I will develop and follow clearly written procedures and policies.
- I will provide a yearly written evaluation for my area of responsibility.
- I will expect success which includes: participant satisfaction, mastery of skills, involvement of the community and financial security.
- · I will set a good example for coaches, players and spectators to follow. This means I will resolve conflict peacefully.
- I will demand that the game officials are treated with respect.
- I understand that public criticism of coaches, officials, players, administrators and spectators is unethical.
- · I understand it is my responsibility to instruct coaches in proper sportsmanship and demand that they make it top priority.
- I will not engage in the use of profanity, obscene language or improper actions.
- I will refrain from the use of illegal drugs, tobacco, and alcohol at all CDAA sports events.

The consequences for violation of the Administrators Code of Conduct are:

- Verbal warning from the CDAA Executive Director or official to stop the behavior that is in violation of this code of conduct.
- If the offensive behavior does not stop, the offending person will be asked to leave the field area.
- 3. If the offending person does not leave the field area willingly, the appropriate authorities will be contacted.
- Finally, the offending person shall be expelled from participating in any CDAA activities until a grievance meeting is held by the appropriate CDAA Committee for each sport and a final recommendation is made.
- 5. The recommendations of the appropriate CDAA Committee for each sport will be the final resolution of the incident and will be acted upon by all parties involved.

I have read and agree to the Administrators Code of Conduct. My signature indicates my willingness to abide by and enforce the CDAA sportsmanship policies and procedures. As an administrator of this organization, I accept the responsibility for role modeling the highest level of sportsmanship and conduct in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
