MNSA Intramural Rules 2007 PreNovice Division

FIFA Laws of the Game 2006/2007 shall apply except as noted.

Law 1 All games will be played on Fields D or E.

The same lines define the goal area and the penalty area.

Law 3 The team shall consist of **Five** players, including the keeper. If one team does not have **Five** players, the other team shall field the same number of players.

Teams may substitute players before goal kicks and throw-ins, and after goals.

Teams may substitute at the end of each quarter and at half time.

Coaches shall inform the referee that they are requesting to make a substitution, and the referee shall delay the start of play until the substitutions are complete. You may not substitute "on the fly".

Players may not enter the field without the referee's permission.

- Law 7 The match shall consist of <u>four Ten-minute quarters</u>. The half time interval is five minutes. The interval after the first and third quarters is two minutes.
- Law 11 The Offside rule shall Not apply.
- Law 12 A player who receives a red card is automatically suspended for the remainder of the game, as well as his/her team's next game.

<u>All free kicks are indirect</u>. There are no penalty kicks or direct free kicks.

All free kicks shall be taken from the point where the foul was committed, except for fouls within the penalty area, which shall be taken from the edge of the penalty area.
