## Payment, Discounts, Refunds and Fees Program Payments

The balance for all programs is due by May 1. All deposits are non-refundable and payments are non-refundable after May 1.

If applying for a program after May 1, the full

balance is due at the time of registration and all payments made are non-refundable. Changes in a camper's schedule may result in full loss of payment for the original program. Payments lost due to withdrawal from a program cannot be forwarded to the next year's programs or to a sibling's account. Any deposit or payment lost due to withdrawal from a program will be contributed to Khary Stockton Programs.

### **Closures & Pro-Rating**

Khary Stockton Summer programs will be closed on the federal holiday for the Fourth of July holiday and no day programs will be conducted. One week sessions that occur during the week of the federal holiday will be pro-rated. Khary Stockton Programs does not pro-rate for partial attendance of a program.

### **Discounts**

### **Family Discount**

### **Withdrawals**

If a student changes classes, including class session, it is considered a withdrawal. Refunds, minus the class deposits, will be granted for withdrawals submitted before May 1, 2011. Please see the cancellation and refund policy for more information.

### **Cancellation and Refund Policy**

Khary Stockton Programs (KSP) reserves the right to cancel any program due to insufficient enrollment.

A full refund will be granted if a class is cancelled. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable between classes, siblings, and other programs offered by KSS, LLC. Refunds are not granted for withdrawals after May 1, 2012. Parents must inform the KSS Office in writing if they are withdrawing their child from any program. Full refunds are granted if a program is full. There are no refunds for absences; there is no provision for make-up classes. No refund will be granted in the event of dismissal for inappropriate or unsafe conduct.

### **Photograph Release**

Khary Stockton Programs requests parents to authorize a photograph release for each participant issuing Khary Stockton Programs the right to photograph, video or record summer participants for the purpose of illustrations, publications and websites. If a guardian wishes to decline this authorization, s/he must indicate this at the time of registration and submit a photograph of their child to Khary Stockton Programs so that we can check photographs taken during the summer.

### **Deposit and Payment**

A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$100 per week must accompany the registration form. The deposit is a flat fee per child. The deposit amount is deducted from the total tuition due. Full payment is due on or before May 1, 2012. If final payment is not received by May 1, the space will be forfeited and given to the next student on the waiting list. If you register after May 1, 2012, full payment is due at the time of registration. A fee of \$25 will be charged for any check we are unable to deposit, or not honored by your bank.

### **Fourth of July Holiday**

KSS is closed on the fourth of July. Camp will be held July 2, 3, 5, 6.

After You Register following receipt of registration, you will receive a confirmation of classes for which you have registered and a statement, including the balance due by May 1, 2012. During the week of May 23-27, staff will be available during designated times to accept any outstanding forms.

#### School Entrance Health Form

St. John Academy is licensed by the Virginia Department of Social Services. As such, each child is required to submit a current immunization record.

Each record must meet the following criteria:

- Indicate that the child is adequately immunized, or has a medical or religious exemption
- Include the dates including the month, day, and year of each vaccine
- Be signed by a physician or his designee, registered nurse, or official of a local health department
- Be accompanied by the Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Health Form

No child will be permitted to participate in KSS camp without having an immunization form on file.

#### Medication Administration

The KSS staff members do not administer non-prescription medications; they will only administer prescription medications. In order for prescription medications to be administered to a student by a KSS staff member, the Authorization/Parental Consent for Administering Medication form must be completed by a parent/guardian and your child's physician. This form must be completed prior to your child's first day at KSS camp, and can be found on the [www.bluesombrero.com/khary](http://www.bluesombrero.com/khary). All medication must be in the original container, with the child's name, the name of the medication, and the dose of the medication indicated on the prescription label. All medication will be kept in the KSS Office. Students are not permitted to carry any medication, including sunscreen and insect repellent, while at KSS camp. St. John Academy requires that all parents/guardians who have informed the KSS Of-

fice that their child has a potentially life-threatening allergy provide the school with at least two EpiPens (epinephrine injectors). If medication and documentation is not provided, the child will be sent home and not permitted to return to KSS Camp until all materials have been submitted. Medication must be picked up at the end of KSS camp week. Any medication not picked up by Monday, August 20, 2012, will be discarded.

#### Proof of Identity

In accordance with the Commonwealth of Virginia childcare center licensing requirements, a parent/guardian must present in person one of the following: a certified copy of a birth certificate; birth registration card; notification of birth; passport; copy of the placement agreement or other proof of child agency; record or report card from a public school in Virginia; or certification by a principal, or his/her designee, of a public school in the United States that a certified copy of the child's record was presented. This information must be provided before the first day of Summer Camp. Please do not mail original documents or send copies via fax.

#### Lunch and Snack

The KSS camp does not provide lunch. Students attending camp weeks as well as Before Care and After Care should pack a bag lunch, drink, and snacks that do not require refrigeration or heating. Lunches must be clearly labeled with the student's name and date. At 12:00 p.m., KSS staff escort students to air-conditioned rooms to eat their lunches. After lunch, students will be monitored. At 12:30 p.m. when lunch ends, students are escorted to their afternoon classes. St. John Academy is a peanut-controlled environment. We request that students not bring anything in their lunches or snacks that contains peanuts, peanut butter, any peanut products, or products containing peanut oil. Please label peanut substitutes accordingly to avoid any

confusion.

#### Communication

Throughout the summer, KSP Office will communicate with families in a variety of ways, including e-mail. Please be sure to have a current e-mail address on file with the office. If you do not have an e-mail account, please contact the Office at (202) 679 – 1389 to make alternate arrangements.

#### Conduct

Khary Stockton Programs follows St. John Academy's conduct and discipline policies and expects students to comply with generally accepted standards of behavior. No refund will be granted in the event of a dismissal for inappropriate or unsafe conduct.

#### Release of Students

The KSP Summer staff will assume that both parents/guardians have equal legal custody of their children and will release children to either parent/guardian unless provided with a copy of legal documentation indicating otherwise. Any changes in who is picking up your child, regardless of whether that person is familiar to the student, must be communicated to the director of KSP in writing. Children will not be released to anyone other than their parent(s)/guardian(s) without a written statement from the parent/guardian with legal custody.

#### Late Pick-ups

Carpool is a very busy time as there are children leaving campus, being dropped off, and moving to new classes. In order to help facilitate children transitioning, carpool ends promptly 10 minutes after its designated start time. Children not picked up within

the allotted 10-minute window will be monitored by a staff member in the front building of St John School and an \$15 late fee will be automatically charged to your account. Any child not picked up at the end of the day by 3:40 p.m. will automatically be enrolled in After care (extended care) for that day. The daily drop-in fee of \$15 will be assessed beginning at 3:40 p.m. After care ends promptly at 6:00 p.m. A late fee per pick-up will be assessed for all pick-ups after 6:00 p.m. Between 6:00 – 6:30 p.m., charges are \$25 for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof. After 30 minutes, charges increase to \$50 for every 15 minutes or fraction thereof. Late pick-up charges will be due the next day in the form of a check payable to Khary Stockton Programs or will be billed to the credit card on file.

### **Before Care**

To accommodate variable schedules, Khary Stockton Programs permits daily before care drop-ins for Before Care, our extended care program from 7:30am – 8:45 a.m. The drop-in fee for Before Care is \$15 per day or \$50 for the week. A completed drop-in form must be on file with the KSP Office before noon on the day your child will need Before Care. Unfortunately, students are not able to attend Before Care without advanced day-of registration. This policy is in place so KSP can provide the safest possible environment for your child.

### **After Care Drop-in**

To accommodate variable schedules, Khary Stockton Programs permits daily drop-ins for After Care, our extended care program from 3:30 – 6:00 p.m. The drop-in fee for Extend the Fun is \$25 per day or \$100 for the week. A completed drop-in form must be on file with the KSP Office before noon on the day your child will need After Care. Unfortunately, students are not able to attend After Care without advanced day-of registration. This policy is in place so KSP can provide the safest possible environment for your child.
