## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

It is the policy of Dixie Youth Baseball, Dixie Boys Baseball and Dixie Softball to promote the development of strong character, a right attitude and a sense of responsibility and citizenship in youngsters, using the games of baseball and softball as a vehicle. It is the purpose of these organizations to achieve this goal through fair play, good sportsmanship and congenial fellowship, with adult leaders providing the example. It is strictly against the policy of these organizations for any person, either as a participant or a spectator to engage in arguments, to use abusive language, to harass umpires, or to exhibit any behavior not in concert with the general intention of this policy statement. Team coaches are required to abide by this policy statement, and all parents and other adults are strongly encouraged to do so.

The City of Montgomery, Parks & Recreation Department has a "ZERO TOLERANCE" policy with regard to misbehavior, or unsportsmanlike conduct or language at the ball field by parents, volunteers or ANY individual. Individuals deemed to be in violation will be asked to leave the park. Repeat offenders may be barred from the ball field grounds.

I agree to abide by both of the above policies.

The Board of Directors of East Montgomery Baseball and Softball Inc, reserves the right to refuse registration to any player or family.

I acknowledge that I have been made aware that East Montgomery maintains an "Abuse / Molestation Risk Management Program" and that the details of the program are available on the East Montgomery website. I further acknowledge that it is my responsibility to review the program details and ask questions if any part of the program is unclear. I may also request a printed copy of the policy from the League Commissioner.

In consideration of participation in East Montgomery Baseball & Softball, the undersigned agrees that their likeness, or the likeness of their child may be photographed or videotaped and that such image may be published in an outlet used to promote or publicize the sports program.

I hereby grant consent to any and all health care providers designated by league representatives to provide my child any necessary medical care as a result of any injury or illness. This consent includes First Aid and transportation to and from health care providers.

Upon discovery of error in registration, any player who registers with East Montgomery but resides within the boundary of another league shall be strongly encouraged to return to the league in whose boundary they reside. A player who refuses to return to their league is at risk of disqualification from tournament play with the East Montgomery league unless they meet one or more of the qualifying exceptions in the rule book.

I agree to return, upon request, the uniform and other equipment issued to the player in the same condition as when received, except for normal wear and tear. I agree to work in the East Montgomery concessions stands during the season when asked by the Team Mother or other League Official.

## EAST MONTGOMERY BALL PARK RULES

- · Illegally Parked Vehicles are subject to be towed at the owner's expense and without further notification.
- East Montgomery is a smoke-free environment.
- · ABSOLUTELY NO soft toss into the fences at ANY time.
- NO alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Anyone acting erratically and/or perceived to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave the park.
- · NO outside food and/or drinks allowed.
- NO skates, roller blades, bicycles, skateboards, rip-sticks or heelies allowed at any time.
- NO animals or pets, other than certified working animals, are allowed in the park.
