Our Academy coaches are expected to create a player centric environment conducive to high-level player development opportunities. This will be accomplished by creating an appropriate training environment for all players that focuses on game understanding in the area of tactics. The quality and mastery of the technical skills within zone objectives, reproducing game intensity situations to promote the physical demands of the game, and competition to create high-quality players.

Coaches will utilize the club's curriculum library (academy software program) when organizing and reviewing training sessions. The session should not be interrupted too often so that players are allowed to freely express themselves and find solutions on their own within their groups. Coaching points should be clear and specific with details restarting practice quickly after points are made.
