Frequently Asked Questions	
What programs do you offer?	We offer recreational and travel soccer programs from U4 up until U19. Visit our programs sections for more details.
Which programs should I sign my child up for?	<p>The programs follow the school year grade level of your player. In the Fall you would register your child for the grade they are entering that Fall. In the Spring you would register your child for the grade they are currently in.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• U4 - Preschool• U6 - Kindergarten• U8 - Grades 1 & 2• U10 - Grades 3 & 4• U12 - Grades 5 & 6• U14 - Grades 7 & 8• U16 - Grades 9 & 10• U19 - Grades 11 & 12
What equipment does my child need?	At all levels your child will need cleats, shin pads, a water bottle, and an appropriately sized soccer ball. On most occasions, the coaches will come prepared with balls for their teams.
Which size soccer ball should I purchase for my child?	<p>As your players go up through the ranks the size of the soccer ball changes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Size 3 for Grade 2 and under• Size 4 for Grade 3-6• Size 5 for Grade 7 and up
How do I sign up?	All registrations are done through our Leicester Soccer Club Sports Connect Website. A link will always be posted in the programs section when available.

	<p>Be mindful that our registration has opening and closing dates, those who miss the closing dates will go to our wait list for the next opportunity.</p>
<p>What if I miss sign ups?</p>	<p>Please refer to our Late Registration Policy, which can be found in the “About Us, Policies” section.</p> <p>Players will go to a waitlist - and the board of directors approval will determine if they can be added for the current season.</p>
<p>What are the uniform requirements for Travel Soccer?</p>	<p>All travel players are required to have Leicester Soccer Club Uniforms in order to participate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Maroon LSC Jersey (with Number) ● Black LSC Shorts ● Black Socks <p>These uniforms are purchased with your registration, and you must indicate whether you are purchasing a new uniform or not each season.</p> <p>New Players to Travel Soccer will HAVE to purchase a uniform.</p>
<p>When do we receive our uniform?</p>	<p>Coaches will be given the new uniforms before the start of the first game.</p>
<p>I live in another town, can I still register for Soccer in Leicester?</p>	<p>Out of town registrants at the In-Town level are allowed (U4-U8) without any approval process.</p> <p>Anyone who is attempting to play Travel Soccer from another town will need an official Waiver Approval that must be agreed upon by both clubs.</p> <p>The same is true of Leicester residents attempting to play elsewhere.</p>
<p>How long is the season?</p>	<p>The Soccer season generally stretches over the course of ten weeks. Both travel leagues plan for a 1-2 week preseason, with regular season games stretching across the remaining 8 weeks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fall - Last Week of August through the first Week of November. ● Spring - Last Week of March through the second week of June.
<p>When is Practice?</p>	<p>Practice times and locations will be communicated by your coach, and will typically fall between 5:00-7:00 pm on weekday nights.</p> <p>Our U4 & U6 programs will have practice sessions on Saturday Mornings.</p>

<p>Where do I go for practice?</p>	<p>Practices from the U4-U12 levels will take place at Community Field on Waite Street. Practices for U14-19 teams will either take place at the Lower Middle School field or on the LHS Turf.</p>
<p>I registered and haven't heard from anyone yet, who do I get in touch with?</p>	<p>Once the Coaches Meetings take place each season and practice times are determined the coaches or "In Town Coordinator" should reach out to communicate start times.</p> <p>If there is a pressing concern please reach out to the Travel and/or In Town coordinators listed on our LSC Board Members tab.</p>
