## Parent and Spectator Code of Conduct

## The following standards are established by the Franklin Youth Soccer Association and govern the behavior of all FYSA Parents, before, during and after soccer club events:

- I will not be a sideline coach or referee. I will provide positive reinforcement, care, and encouragement to my child and his/her teammates. I will also refrain from making negative comments to my child or his/her teammates.
- 2. I will support coaches and officials who instruct my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 3. As a parent and spectator I will cheer for my team from the spectators area and will not sit or stand near the goals or players sidelines during a match.
- 4. I promise to treat other fans, coaches, players, and officials with respect, regardless of race, gender, or ability.
- 5. I acknowledge that the coaches are volunteers and are responsible for the entire team including parents.
- 6. I will remember that as a fan, I represent the Franklin Youth Soccer Association and the community. I understand poor behavior during practices, games, or tournaments may result in expulsion from the soccer complex. (I must wait inside or next to my car in the parking area for my son or daughter). If this happens repeatedly, it will result in expulsion from the Club.
