SPRING LETTER

Coaches,

In an effort to find practice space for ROFC's recreational teams for the spring season, below is a list of potential practice areas in the city of Royal Oak. A friendly reminder, please do not practice on the game fields listed below. If you find space outside of the actual game field, please feel free to set up shop when games are NOT being played. But please do not use the game field or goals for practices. Two exceptions would be Quickstad and Red Run. Please do not practice near the game fields at these parks at any time.

Also, note that these parks/schools are on a first-come, first-use basis. There are no permits issued to ROFC or individual teams. However, always be mindful of those parks where the Royal Oak Sandlot League (ROSL) is playing baseball/softball games. They do have permits for those parks beginning May 1 - and if they feel soccer teams are in harm's way, they can request that we leave the field of play. So please practice well away from any baseball/softball games and practices. ROSL does have a permit for the baseball/softball fields at Red Run, so please steer clear of those fields if you see game/practice going on.

Please do not practice - at any time - at Red Oaks park in Madison Heights. These fields are operated by Madison Heights Youth Soccer and are for scheduled game use only. Lastly, Royal Oak High School has asked that we not use any of the high school land for practices. Their ongoing construction at the school has pushed high school athletic teams to other areas surrounding the high school. That being said, we are attempting to consolidate our ROFC premier training at both Royal Oak Middle School as well as at Dickinson Park. This will help us free up additional training space around the city for our 120 recreational teams.

- Pioneer Park (on Parkway, near Woodward and Normandy smaller teams)
- Westwood Park (off Warick Rd, one block W of Woodward behind Arby's small teams)
- Starr Jaycee (small part off Marais and Poplar small teams)

Northeast Royal Oak

- Exchange Park (In center part of the park, away from the two baseball fields)
- Optimist Park (east of the baseball field small area to practice on for U10 or younger)
- Cody Park (corner of Cody and 12 Mile across from Red Run GC small teams)
- Waterworks Park (outside of game field please practice well off the game field if being used) Southeast Royal Oak
