- (1) **U16/U19 SMALL-SIDED: MODIFICATIONS AS U11/12 LISTED ABOVE EXCEPT FOR GK PLAY TIME RESTRICTION, WITH 35 AND 40 MINUTE HALVES, RESPECTIVELY.**
- (2) **ALL TEAMS MUST PLAY AT EVEN STRENGTH UNLESS A TEAM HAS HAD A PLAYER SENT OFF/EJECTED (RED CARD).**
- (3) **A TEAM NOT FIELDING THE REQUIRED MINIMUM NUMBER OF PLAYERS WITHIN 10 MINUTES AFTER THE SCHEDULED START TIME OF THE GAME WILL HAVE FORFEITED THE GAME.**
- (4) ***U10 AND UNDER: When a player deliberately heads the ball in a game, an indirect free kick (IFK) should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense. If the deliberate header occurs within the goal area, the IFK should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred. If a player does not deliberately head the ball, then play should continue.***

* Any violation of these rules by a coach may result in sanctioning, up to and including that coach's dismissal. For U9 and above age groups, violations may also result in forfeiture of the game.
