

# ***AEYSA Player's Code of Conduct***

I hereby pledge to be positive about my youth sports experience and accept responsibility for my participation by following the ***Players Code of Conduct***.

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship from my fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at every game, practice and sporting event by demonstrating good sportsmanship.
2. I will attend every practice, game, and event that I possibly can and will notify my coach if I cannot.
3. I will do my very best to listen and learn from my coaches.
4. I will refrain from talking back or being disruptive.
5. I will treat my coaches, directors, teammates, officials, and fans with respect, and I expect to be treated the same.
6. I will not use profanity or derogatory comments to teammates, coaches, officials and fans at all practices, games and sporting events and expect all adults to refrain from the same.
7. I will encourage my parents to be involved with my Allen East Youth Sports team in some capacity because it's important to me.
8. I will act as a responsible representative of Allen East and will show respect for my community and others at all times.
9. I will do my best in school and put my school work and homework before everything else.
10. I will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn, grow and have fun.
11. AEYSA will follow OHSAA Regulations on Scholarship and Sporting Behavior ([www.ohsaa.org](http://www.ohsaa.org)). These include, but are not limited to:
  - Any student athlete who is determined to be academically ineligible (by their school) is prohibited from participating in all AEYSA games/competitions for the duration of the period of ineligibility as determined by OHSAA rules and guidelines. OHSAA Regulations on Scholarship are applicable to AEYSA student athletes in 7<sup>th</sup> grade or higher.
  - The eligibility or ineligibility of a student continues until the start of the fifth school day of the next grading period.
  - Any student suspended or expelled from school shall be ineligible for AEYSA games/competitions for the duration of the suspension or expulsion.
  - Any student athlete who is ejected or disqualified from a game, will be ineligible for all contests for the remainder of that day and be ineligible for the next two games (one in football).
  - All athletic contests in which ineligible players have participated shall be forfeited.
  - OHSAA Regulations on Sporting Behavior are applicable to all AEYSA student athletes.
