

## **WYS Tennis Lessons 2025**

Tennis lessons are open to tennis players ages 5-up during Monday-Thursday. We have lessons that last 45 minutes, for the younger players and 1-hour lessons for the “older” players. This year we are offering advanced lessons as well as lessons for adults. We are also offering tournament play for players who want competitive experience, when possible. Please refer to lesson descriptions and prerequisites before placing yourself or your child in a class as our lessons build on skills from previous skill development.

**Each session is 4 weeks long.**

- **Session I: June 30 to July 25.**
- **Session II: July 28 to August 22.**

#### **Beginner Classes: (Ages 7-12)**

Description: An introduction to tennis for our youngest players. The student will be introduced to basic skills like hand-eye coordination and footwork. Students will be exposed to forehand, backhand, serve, volley, and gameplay using low- compression balls.
