Boca Raton, May 15, 2014 - Boca United FC is proud to announce it has been selected as a member of the Elite Clubs National League, the premier soccer league for females in the country for the 2015-16 season! Boca United is the first and only club in South Florida to be accepted into the ECNL. League play for Boca United will begin in the U14 – U18 age groups for the 2015-2016 season.

The Elite Clubs National League (the "ECNL") was founded in 2009 to transform the developmental experience of female youth soccer players in the United States through: (i) improving the competitive environment for youth female soccer players; (ii) improving the process for identifying elite female soccer players for the US Soccer youth national teams; and (iii) improving the daily training environment at female youth soccer clubs through standardizing best practices and training and organizational guidelines. The ECNL is the top competition and development platform for youth female soccer players in the United States, and consists of 77 of the top female youth soccer clubs across the country.

As an ECNL member club, Boca United's top players have the opportunity to participate in the ECNL Player Development Programs, which provide additional opportunity for top players for identification for US Youth National Teams and Division 1 College Coaches.

The ECNL is the training ground for the next generation of college stars. Over 90% of the 2015 ECNL graduating class will continue on to play college level, 80% will be playing in Division 1, and 66 players in the 2014 NCAA Division 1 Final Four played in the ECNL as youth.
