Scott is entering his fourth year with WFC Rangers and brings nearly two decades of top-level coaching experience to the club. In his tenure with Rangers, his teams have made two appearances in state cup finals — his Rangers BU18 team was a finalist in the 2012 Championship Cup and his Rangers BU16 team won the 2011 Challenge Cup. Before joining Rangers in 2010, Scott coached in the Whatcom Development League from 2007-2010. He also has worked with Eastside FC in Bellevue and the former Washington Soccer Club (now FC Alliance) in Bothell. Scott also served as an assistant coach for Washington Youth Soccer's state Olympic Development Program teams from 1998-2003, winning a national ODP title in 2002. In addition to his work with youth soccer teams, Scott served as head coach for the men's and women's varsity teams at Bothell High School from 1998-2002, and as assistant women's varsity coach for Eastlake High School from 1995-1997, in 1999 and in 2003. Scott was named coach of the year in 1999 and 2001 for his work at Bothell, and Eastlake won a state championship in 2003 while Scott was on the staff. Scott also coached the Washington Under-23 women's amateur team in 2003, and the Hibernian Saints and Diadora women's amateur teams from 2000-2002. In addition to coaching duties with the Rangers, Scott works for Washington Youth Soccer as a staff instructional coach, conducting coaching clinics and workshops. He holds the United States Soccer Federation 'B' license and the USSF National Youth Module certificate.
