



Sports Quest Partners With Fairfield Baptist Church “Liberian Orphanage” – June 2011

Members of the Fairfield Baptist Church’s Mission Team traveled to Liberia to minister to the children of the Fairfield Baptist Mission Orphanage. Sports Quest was privileged to support the mission by providing soccer uniforms/clothing donated through its “Second Kick” donation Program.

“Fairfield Baptist Church sent two members of their mission team to Monrovia Liberia to check in on the orphanage that they support. The team left on June 18th and returned on June 30th.

While in Liberia, they ministered to the orphans in a variety of ways. The children enjoyed crafts, playing games, puzzles and play dough. They took their first field trip to a nearby beach and experienced their first ever birthday party. At the birthday party the children were presented with gifts and cards provided by their sponsoring families. The older children participated in evangelism training utilizing the e-band and e-ball as evangelism tools. The children then participated in a street soccer game and then shared Christ with the participants using the colors of salvation on the e-ball.

The ministry team delivered uniforms to the mission school for the girls’ kickball teams and boys’ soccer teams. These uniforms were provided through money raised by the Fairfield Baptist Children’s ministry. In addition, soccer jerseys and socks were provided to the orphans through Sports Quest.
