I, like most of the Board Members and many of you, we're hoping that we would be able to get the players back on the field and at least be able to get some of the season played. However, after working very hard with City officials who are mandated to follow State Health Guidelines, the continuation of the season will be impossible.

By Lake Elsinore Little League Constitution, a new Board of Directors will take over the running of League business over the next couple of weeks. With that said, they will be looking at the finances of the League and determining the feasibility of discounts for players for future seasons since the 2020 spring season was not completed. More information on this will be forthcoming once the new Board of Directors is able to meet.

Also, by Constitution, a complete financial record of Lake Elsinore Little League is to be available for General Members at Closing Ceremonies of the Spring Season. Since we were not able to have a Closing Ceremony, a profit/loss statement for the 2020 Spring Season are posted on the web site under *About Us > Our Finances > Financial Reports*, so that everyone can review how money was spent for the most recent season. Unfortunately for the League, we loss over \$6,000 for the 2020 Spring Season. The Board of Directors will be working with vendors to recover some of those costs.

I understand the outcome of the 2020 Lake Elsinore Little League season was very disappointing for everyone. I wish things would have been different. However, with the current situation, let's keep things in perspective. Please continue to follow the health guidelines and remain healthy, and we will hopefully be back playing baseball once again soon. Stay Safe!
