## **Dribbling**

- Touch the ball a lot  
Touch the ball a lot  
Make a move

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- 1) Weighted Pass
  - 2) Precise Pass

## **Passing**

- Pass  
Make pass to target

- 1) Get Open
- 2) Show for the ball
- 3) Meet the ball

- Get away from opponent  
Have a clear path to goal  
Go to the ball

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- 1) Control the ball
  - 2) Receive ball with chest
  - 3) Get over the ball

## **Receiving**

- Stop the ball  
Stop the ball with body  
brings foot over the ball.

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- 1) Keep your eye on the
  - 2) Ball while heading

## **Heading**

- Open your eyes and  
and watch the ball

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- 1) Take a Defensive stand
  - 2) No Fouls
  - 3) Shield the ball

- slow down you opponent  
play the ball.  
keeps your body between ball

- 1) Attack your opponent
- 2) Stay goal side
- 3) Shifting the point of attack

## **1v.1**

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- 1) Positional Play
  - 2) Marking

## **Basic Tactics**

- stays in position  
cover your opponent

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- 1) Inside Step
  - 2) Outside step
  - 3) Get comfortable
