### Administrative Information

#### Pre-Match

- Each team provides an official NJYS computer generated (GotSoccer) gamecard with *no handwritten information (except jersey numbers) to the referee.*
- Each player and coach must present a valid USYS member pass that matches the NJYS game card. After inspecting the passes, the Referee will possess them until the completion of the match.
- A team may receive a 15-minute grace period to field a minimum of 7 players. In the event a team cannot field the minimum number of players within this period, the referee will complete a supplemental report, sent to NJYS. The referee may NOT make a forfeit determination.

#### Post-Match

- The referee will report the score and misconduct via an online match report within 24 hours of match completion.
- The referee must submit apparent serious injuries, send-offs, and/or unusual game incidents that require a supplemental report to NJYS ([statecups@njyouthsoccer.com](mailto:statecups@njyouthsoccer.com)) within 24 hours of match completion.

#### Game Fees

The referee fees will be evenly split by teams (except in the semi-finals and finals).

### Competition Modifications

#### Substitutions

- Substitutions may be made, with the consent of the referee, at any stoppage of play.
- Unlimited Substitutions
  - A player, substitute, and/or substituted player may re-enter the match without limit.

#### Player Safety

- Apparent Head Injuries
  - If a player is suspected of suffering a head injury, they may be substituted for evaluation without the substitution counting against the team's total number of permitted substitutions during each half or overtime period (in competitions where substitutions may be limited). This may only occur if the team has a substitution available.
  - If the player with the apparent head injury receives clearance from the event's health care professional (if applicable), the player may re-enter the match for the player that temporarily replaced them. The temporary replacement player may re-enter the game as a regular substitute.
