As a condition of having a player representing a CYFA team, parents/guardians agree to:

- 1. Become educated and use the best practices for the health and safety of my player, especially as it relates to concussion awareness and heat preparedness.
- 2. Demonstrate support for players, coaches, and officials at games, practices, or other CYFA events.
- 3. Have your child at practices and games on time and fully dressed.
- 4. Refrain from profanity, taunting, or derogatory remarks about players from any team, coaches or officials during CYFA events.
- 5. Refrain from attempting to coach your player from the stands.
- 6. Adhere to the Sideline Rules, only lanyard persons may be on the sideline.
- 7. Leave the field/premises if you are getting angry or frustrated until regaining composure.
- 8. Adhere to the "24" Hour Rule, if you are angry or frustrated do not contact your team's coach until 24 hours has passed.
- 9. Not discuss other players' abilities or playing time with your coach, only discuss your own child.
- 10.Refrain from the use of any tobacco products or alcohol at any practices or game.
- 11. Be held responsible for the behavior of any guest they bring to a CYFA event
- 12. Communicate any concerns about your player's safety or well being to the coach immediately.

I agree to follow the Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct as stated and understand that failure to abide by this code may result in disciplinary measures including prohibition from attending CYFA games and/or practices, expulsion of my player(s) from CYFA without a refund, or any combination thereof, at the discretion of the CYFA Board.
