## ANCHORAGE YOUTH SOCCER CLUB





Anchorage Youth Soccer Club offers partial scholarships to youth soccer players in need of financial assistance. As scholarship funds are limited, we ask that when you pick up an application, please ask yourself if you are truly in need of funds. It is important to understand that financial aid is directly dependant on the amount of funds available and the number of applications received. In an effort to fairly distribute what funds we have available, our application is in-depth and requires supporting documentation. No applications will be considered without supplying ALL supporting documentation.

The Club's funds are limited and scholarships are limited to, at most, 50% of a player's fees. 100% scholarships are never awarded. It is important to note that not only does the Club abide by a no-pay-no-play policy, but those players with outstanding balances from previous sessions are not eligible for scholarships. Any scholarship funds received are used to supplement Club fees only; team travel expenses, uniforms, and additional events are not covered by scholarships.

Financial assistance is limited and is awarded on a session basis only—a new application needs to be submitted for each session. Note that financial aid awarded during a soccer session does not necessarily indicate financial assistance for future sessions. Remember that monthly payment plans are available.

Financial assistance eligibility:

- 1. You must be willing to discuss personal financial matters with a member of the scholarship committee.
- 2. Both parents/guardians along with the player are agreeable to actively participate in future team and club fundraisers and contribute volunteer time to AYSC.
- 3. You understand that you will be responsible for paying the balance of the player's fees that is not covered by financial assistance.

Scholarship applications are due two weeks prior to the start of each program's session. In certain circumstances, applications received after that time may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. We cannot promise financial assistance to those individuals whose applications are late.

To apply for scholarships through Anchorage Youth Soccer Club, please submit the following to your team manager to forward to the scholarship committee:

- 1. Completed scholarship application form
- 2. Recent paystubs for all working adults in the household
- 3. Most recent completed 1040 Tax Return (pages 1 and 2 only) for both parents/guardians
- 4. Any other documentation that might help us understand your need
