United Soccer of Auburn, led by Massachusetts Youth Soccer will be conducting evaluations of all players entering the U10, U12, and U14 travel leagues. This correlates with students entering grades 3 – 8 for the 2021-2022 school year.

The evaluations will take place on June 8th - 10th. Due to the large number of players, we are holding evaluation sessions as outline below. Please make every effort to get your child there.

## June 8 (Tuesday):

5 – 6:30 p.m., all Boys entering or remaining in the U10 travel league, grades 3 or 4 in the fall. 6:30 – 8:00 p.m., all Boys entering or remaining in the U12 travel league, grades 5 or 6 in the fall.

## June 8 (Wednesday):

5 – 6:30 p.m., all Girls entering or remaining in the U10 travel league, grades 3 or 4 in the fall. 6:30 – 8:00 p.m., all Girls entering or remaining in the U12 travel league, grades 5 or 6 in the fall.

## June 10 (Thursday):

5 – 6:30 p.m., all Boys entering or remaining in the U14 travel league, grades 7 or 8 in the fall. 6:30 – 8:00 p.m., all Girls entering or remaining in the U14 travel league, grades 7 or 8 in the fall.

- When you come to the field, there will be a registration table. Players will be assigned a numbered bib, and players at random will be given a pinney to help sort them into random groups.
- We ask that all players have their own ball, water, and are dressed to play (cleats, shin guards).
- All COVID-19 policies will be in place as defined by MYSA, EEA etc. at the time of evaluations.
- During the evaluations, players will essentially be scrimmaging. As the session continues, the coaches will stop and shuffle groups, but then the groups will continue to scrimmage.
- Please emphasize to your child that these are individual evaluations and that players should look to showcase all facets of their skill, including dribbling, passing, offensive and defensive skills, communication with others, and effort.
- These evaluations will provide information that is used during team rostering. If your child is playing
  on a team currently, your coach(es) will be providing additional information about your child's skill
  set. All of this information is used by United Soccer of Auburn to help create teams for the Fall of
  2021.
- Please emphasize to the players (and yourself) that this should not be a stressful event. They will be playing the game we all love and this is just one tool to help us.
- The organizations objectives for creating travel rosters are to place each player on a team best suited for their individual technical, tactical, emotional and social development
