

# Rules Fall 2017 Boys-Girls U6/7 Revised 8/9/17

1. Field size: Shall be modified as needed, per Club.

2. Ball size: U06 / 07 shall be size #3.

- 3. Players: Maximum number of players on the field at any one time shall be 3 a side (girls) 4 a side (boys). No goal keeper. All players should be given 50% playing time per game. Coaches must agree on players on the field and can vary from game to game.
- 4. Substitutions: Unlimited substitutions may be made "on the fly".
- 5. Home Team shall be listed first on the schedule. Team listed as visitor will rotate.
- 6. Player's equipment:
  - a) Players must not use equipment or wear anything which is dangerous to themselves or another player; includes jewelry of any kind.
  - b) Jersey or shirt, shorts, stockings and appropriate footwear, i.e. tennis shoes, soft-cleats
  - c) Shinguards are MANDATORY and must be covered entirely by stockings.
  - d) Home team will change if there is a color conflict.

### 7. Duration of game:

## Girls (8 team division)

- a) There will be four (4) rotations of twelve (12) minute games.
- b) There should be a three to five (3-5) minute break between rotations.
- c) Please wait for timekeeper to blow horn to start and stop games.

### Boys (6 team division)

- a) There will be three (3) rotations of fifteen (15) minute games.
- b) There should be a three to five (3-5) minute break between rotations.
- c) Please wait for timekeeper to blow horn to start and stop games.
- 8. Start of Play: As soon as ball is touched and moves. Opponents must be eight (8) yards from the center mark while kick-off is in progress.
- 9. Ball in and Out of Play: When the ball has wholly crossed the goal line or touch line whether on the ground or in the air.
- 10. Scoring: Shall conform to FIFA. A goal may not be scored directly from a kickoff. No standings will be kept.

- 11. Throw-in: Conform to FIFA with the exception that a second throw-in shall be awarded. Coach should instruct player in proper procedure of taking the throw-in.
- 12. Goal Kicks: Conform to FIFA. Coach should instruct players' reason and proper procedure of taking a goal kick.
- 13. Corner Kicks: Conform to FIFA with the following exception: Opponents must be six (6) yards from the ball. Coach should instruct players' reason and proper procedure of taking a corner kick.
- 14. Offside: There shall be no offside.
- 15. Slide tackling: There shall be no slide tackling!!!!!
- 16. Fouls and Misconduct: Shall conform to FIFA with the following exceptions apply:
  - a) All fouls including slide tackling shall result in an INDIRECT free kick.
  - b) There shall be no penalty kicks.
  - c) Opponents shall be six (6) yards away.
- 17. End of Game: Opposing coaches and players shall shake hands after each game.
- 18. Referee:
  - a) Home team will be responsible to provide a referee, preferably a parent or sibling not the coach.
  - b) Rule infractions should be briefly explained to the offending player and coach.
- 19. Heading: Is not allowed in practice or games per USYSA mandate at this age.
- 20. Playing with casts or splints is prohibited.

### Coaches Responsibility:

- a) Provide a safe and positive playing environment for his/her players.
- b) Shall encourage good sportsmanship at all times in words and action.
- c) Shall enforce appropriate and positive sideline behavior by all spectators on their sideline.
- d) Shall not harass or attempt to intimidate a referee at anytime!
- e) Shall assist with field preparation as needed at club request.
- f) Shall assist club with enforcing all rules set forth by the club.
- g) Shall ensure sideline is cleaned up after each game.

### Club Responsibility:

- a) Provide a safe and positive playing environment for our players, coaches and spectators.
- b) Ensure fields are available for practices and games.
- c) Provide coaches with training materials/clinics. Recognizing that this may vary from season to season depending on the availability of volunteers, trainers and/or funds.
- d) Assist coaches with problems that can arise during league play; i.e., player discipline, sideline behavior.

# The following rules/guideline shall be followed at all times:

- 1. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed or used on or near the playing area.
  - 2. No tobacco products shall be consumed or used near the playing area.
- 3. No illegal or controlled substances shall be consumed or used near the playing area.
- 4. No firearms or weapons of any kind shall be used or allowed near the playing area.
- 5. No pets shall be allowed near the playing area at any time.
  - 6. For any issue not addressed here NCYSA/WYS/USYSA/FIFA rules will apply.
- 7. The Sky River Soccer Club reserves the right to amend these rules as needed for the benefit of our club and membership.
