GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Umpire Information</u> - Mark Smith, District 9 UIC (contact information above) will coordinate umpires. Local umpires will be used for all Tournament games.

<u>**Registration</u>** - Registration will take place at West Springfield High School from 1-4 PM on Wednesday, July 13. At this time each team should provide their team roster, completed affidavit, and checks for the team's t-shirts and extra picnic tickets.</u>

<u>Picnic</u> - The pre-tournament picnic catered by Natural Red Barbecue will take place in the cafeteria at West Springfield High School at 5 PM on July 13.

<u>Opening Ceremonies</u> - Opening Ceremonies will be held in the West Springfield High School baseball stadium at 6:30 PM on July 13. Players should wear their team shirts, no cleats!

Managers, Coaches and Umpires Meeting - The meeting will be held in Spartan Hall at West Springfield High School (direction signs will be provided) immediately following the Opening Ceremony. Approximate start time will be 7:30 PM, July 13.

Fees - There are no fees for admission or parking. District 9 and West Springfield Little League will appreciate donations when the hat is passed at each game to help defray the many costs associated with holding the tournament.

Parking - Ample parking is available at Byron Park. Please avoid spots reserved for handicapped persons, emergency vehicles and tournament staff. Please also be aware that some areas are more prone to foul balls than others.

<u>Pregame Procedures</u> - Teams should be at the field at least 45 minutes prior to their game time. As soon as you arrive report to the tournament director for the coin flip. Home team will occupy the first base dugout. While at the tournament location, warm-ups will only occur inside the designated field at the allowed time, unless otherwise allowed by the Tournament Director. NO BATTING PRACTICE of any kind will be allowed at the tournament field.

At 30 minutes prior to game time visiting team will take the field for warmups.

At 20 minutes prior to game time home team will take the field for warmups.

At 10 minutes prior to game time players, coaches, tournament director and umpires will be introduced. Players will line up behind the base lines as they are introduced. We will recite the Little League Pledge and Little League Parent Pledge. The National Anthem will be played prior to the first game each day. Coaches will meet with the Umpires for the pre-game conference. All players will remain in the dugout during this time. Then we will "Play Ball".

Practices - Practice fields will be provided by Central Springfield Little League at Trailside Park, 6001 Trailside Dr., Springfield, VA 22150. A digital sign-up form for practice slots will be posted on the tournament website. Field use will be limited to 1-hour blocks of time.

<u>Team Equipment</u> - All bats, helmets and other equipment must meet Little League requirements. Any non-approved equipment should not be brought to the game site. Prior to each game, teams will line up their equipment, including all bats, helmets and catcher's gear, in front of their dugout for umpire inspections.

<u>Spectator Policies and Procedures</u> - No noise makers of any kind will be allowed. Bleacher seating will be provided but you are welcome to bring your lawn chairs, canopies or tarps. There will be a concession stand open during the tournament. With the exception of the host league/district, no spectator's equipment associated with streaming of games may be affixed to any location on the playing facility including lighting stanchion and fencing. <u>Concession and Vendor Information</u> -The Byron Park Concessions Stand will be open each day of the tournament from approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of the first game until approximately 30 minutes after the completion of the last game. Cash and credit cards are accepted. In addition to the regular menu listed below, a unique item from outside vendors will be available each afternoon (e.g., Chick-Fil-A, Papa Johns, etc.). Also, each morning, donuts and/or breakfast burritos will be available.
