Opening Day Has a Special Guest

The Inspirational Story of Nick Balenger

Each year WSLI kicks off the season with the traditional opening day ceremonies. One of the highlights is the traditional throwing of the first pitch to open the season. This past year was a very special year as we invited Nick Balenger, a former WSLI player to do the honors.

Nick started with WSLI at 6 years old as a Single A Diamondback and finished as a 12 year old with the Majors Red Sox. He played three years of All Stars, and was a member of the 2007 10/11 State Champions team. Like many WSLI parents, Nick's dad, Steve, managed and coached several of his WSLI teams, and his Mom, Sylvie, could always be found in the stands at Byron cheering him on. Like many of the kids who "graduate" from WSLI, Nick went on to play successfully at the high school level, and last year realized a childhood dream of winning the State Championship as a Lake Braddock Bruin. While being recruited by college teams and preparing for his senior year, Nick made time to return to his baseball "roots," coming back to Byron to pitch batting practice to the 10/11 AL all stars as they prepared for the tournament.

At this point, Nick's story took a horribly unexpected turn. While on a family vacation in Hawaii, he sustained a spinal cord injury that left him paralyzed from the chest down. After two surgeries to stabilize and fuse his spine, Nick spent 19 days in ICU on Maui, and 67 days as an inpatient at a rehabilitation hospital in Washington, D.C. He

was initially given little chance of walking again, but Nick made it his mission to prove the doctors wrong. Drawing on the tenacity and grit that served him so well as a baseball player, Nick battled pain and worked to the point of exhaustion in the fight for progress every day. Those who watched Nick on the mound for years note that he was not an overpowering pitcher, but rather one that "grinded it out" with "grace under fire." These character traits, battle-tested and honed on the baseball diamond, helped Nick defy the odds as he stood on the Wrigley mound to throw out our first pitch. As parents, we tell our kids that this game is about much more than a ball and a bat and that competitive sports prepare you for life, but Nick is the living proof. His parents say that his drive stems from a competitive desire to walk again.

Nick's story also illustrates the powerful bonds that are forged on these fields at Byron among our players and our families. Within days of Nick being injured, his two best friends, whom he first became close with when they played WSLI together, flew nearly 5000 miles to Hawaii to be by his side. Our 10/11 boys wore his number on their arms and in their hearts at Regionals and have become true buddies to Nick just as he has become a role model for them. Several of our WSLI families established a fund raising committee to support Nick and help with medical costs. Even the generator that runs our pitching machines here at Byron helped keep the Balenger home running smoothly during Hurricane Sandy! We are so pleased to have him kick off our season, as Nick's achievements as well as the manner in which our WSLI family has rallied around the Balengers are reminders of all that is right and best about this game and our league.

Since opening day, Nick has continued to make great progress. He graduated from Lake Braddock High School, defying the odds once again as he walked across the stage to receive his diploma. He was accepted to all of the colleges he applied to, and has deferred his admission to James Madison University until next year so that he can continue to focus on maximizing his recovery as his doctors have recommended. In the meantime, he is taking classes at George Mason, is the first person to participate in a pilot doctoral program at George Mason developing an aggressive exercise program for spinal cord injury patients, and challenging himself daily with his personal trainers to get stronger and walk further

The West Springfield Little League family wishes Nick continued improvement as he continues to improve 'one step at a time.'

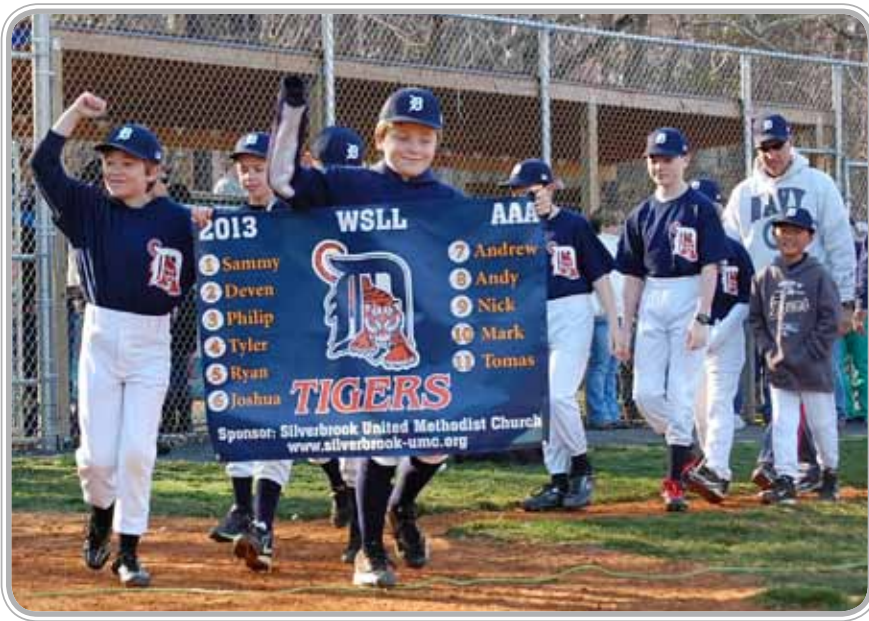

George Pedersen



George Pedersen Volunteer of the Year, '02 & '03

For the past 14 years George Pedersen has been a member of West Springfield Little League. We would like to give special recognition to George for his many years of service to the League.

George joined the WSLL Board of Directors in 2002 and became chairman of the fields and facilities at Byron Avenue Park. He spent countless hours at Byron and set a new standard for field care at Byron that has carried forward since then. That same year he was named WSLL Volunteer of the Year and received the award again in 2003. Soon after, this award was officially changed to the George Pedersen Volunteer of the Year Award in his honor.



In 1999 WSLL began development of what is now Fenway Park at Burke School. In 2001 George was one of the main volunteers that helped in the development of Fenway Park. Since then he has been responsible for most of the improvements at Fenway. He designed and supervised the installation of a batting cage, which was installed along the third base line, and the construction of new dugouts at the field. Mr. Pedersen personally supervised all of this work, most which was completed during the months of January and February 2003 when temperatures were often at or below freezing. The first West Springfield games were played on the newly refurbished Burke School field in 2003. In 2007, George built a concession stand at Fenway and since then he has become a permanent fixture there running the stand almost every night and on Saturdays in addition to single handedly maintaining the fields.

The WSLL Board of Directors and families thank you for all of your dedication and work to WSLL.

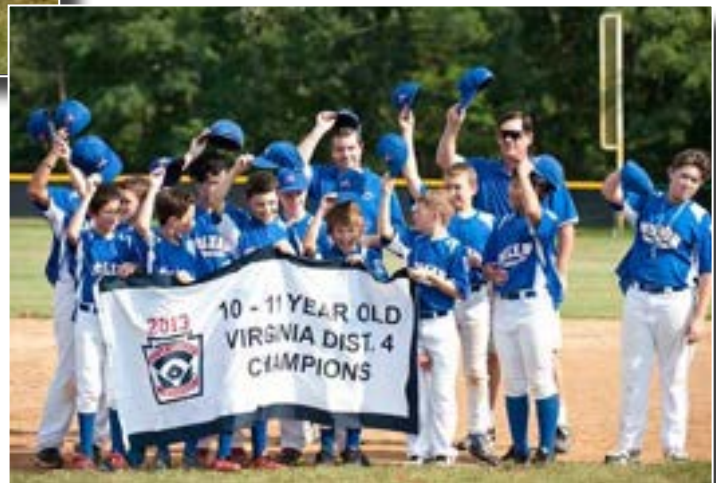
