



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Be respectful of others, be responsible, play fair and do your best. As a Lincoln Little League player, I hereby pledge that I will:

- Treat everyone as I would want to be treated.
- Always play with my best effort.
- Be a team player and support my teammates.
- Not bullying, name calling or making others feel bad.
- Be on time and attend every practice and game that I can and notify my coaches if I cannot.
- Work hard to improve my skills.

- Never throw equipment (bats, bags, bases, etc.).
- Learn and obey the rules of the game and always work for the good of the team.
- Accept the decisions of the officials. Refrain from challenging or questioning on-field calls by officials and/or managers and coaches.
- Conduct myself with honor and dignity.
- Congratulate the other team after each game as a demonstration of goodwill.

GAME PLAY CONDUCT

- Any Manager, Coach, Player, or Parent ejected by an umpire during a game will be suspended for the remainder of the game and the next physically played game.
- Any Manager, Coach, Player, or Parent involved in a heated argument with a Plate Umpire, Field Umpire, or another Manager or Coach, may be suspended.
- The use of inappropriate language by Managers, Coaches, Players, or parents will not be tolerated under any circumstances. The use of such language may result in a one game suspension. The Zero Tolerance policy will be strictly enforced!
- Any Players, Managers, or Coaches throwing field equipment may be subject to suspension.
