This form must be read and agreed to by each parent or guardian involved in the player's RSC athletic experience. Please sign this form and return to the Coach. Please keep a copy of this document for your reference.

- I pledge to provide positive support and encouragement for my child participating in the RSC sports by following the Parent(s)/Guardian(s) Code of Conduct (PCOC)
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, game officials, administrators and spectators at all times.
- I will remember that kids play to have fun and the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will focus on fun, participation, and individual skill development rather than on winning or losing.
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, administrators and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, sex or ability.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or others for a mistake or for losing.
- I will respect the officials and their authority. I will not argue with or criticize game officials.
- I will respect the Coaches for their decisions. If I have an issue, I will speak to the Coach off the field when there are no players present.
- I and my guests will refrain from the use of illegal drugs and alcohol at all RSC sports events. I am strongly encouraged to refrain from the use of tobacco at all RSC sports events for the health of the participants and enjoyment of the game.
- I will make every effort to get my child to practice and games on time, pick them up on time and in the event that we will miss a practice or a game, we will let the Coach know as soon as possible.



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The consequences for violation of the Parent(s)/Guardian(s) Code of Conduct are:

1. Verbal warning from the Coach or official to stop the behavior that in violation of this PCOC.
2. If the offensive behavior does not stop, the offending person will be asked to leave the field area.
3. If the offending person does not leave the field area willingly, the appropriate authorities will be contacted.
4. Finally, the offending person shall be expelled from participating in any RSC activity until a grievance meeting is held by the appropriate RSC committee.
5. The recommendations of the RSC committee will be the final resolution of the incident and will be acted upon by all parties.
