

GFC Code of Conduct

Standards of Conduct are defined within the Georgia State Soccer Association Discipline & Protest Policies & Procedures (revised 4/23/12) – the following subset of conduct standards, further enacted by Georgia FC, are set forth to govern the behaviors of players, coaches, and spectators before, during, and after soccer matches at all locations (home, away and tournaments). Failure to meet the GFC Code of Conduct may result in warning, game suspension(s), or club expulsion. The following code of conduct is expected:

- A consistently positive attitude shall be conveyed towards players, coaches, officials, and spectators
- Respect for referee, either on field or in field's general area, must be shown by all
- Proper respect for players, opposing teams, and spectators must be exhibited by all
- All that is dishonorable and unsporting is particularly and expressly condemned
- Offensive, insulting, and abusive language will not be tolerated, either on field of play or in field's general area
- Dangerous play must not be taught or encouraged
- Physical violence, foul and abusive language, harassment of players, referees or spectators **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**
