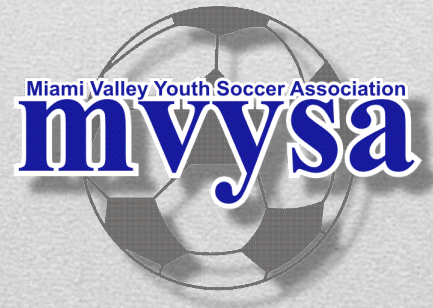




How to Fix a Photo

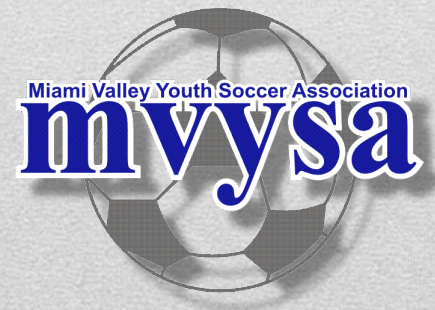
Updated 6/15/2018 for use with US
Soccer Connect system



- 200 pixels high by 150 pixels wide
- Face and Shoulders Only
- Color
- Clear
- No sun glasses or hats
- Photo taken within past 6 months



Photo Requirements



You can use most any photo editing software to prepare player and coach photos for upload to the US Soccer Connect system.

The website picresize.com is a free and simple place to edit a photo.

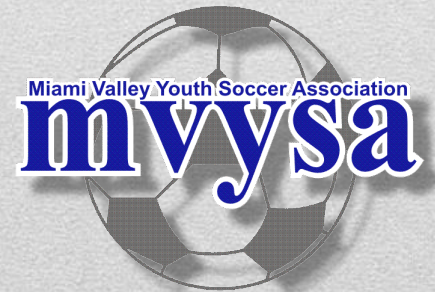
Using picresize.com



1. Click on Browse and choose the photo from your computer


2. Then Click the yellow

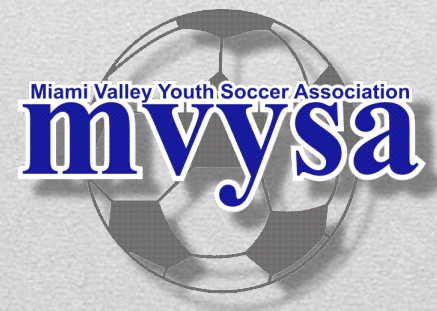


Using picresize.com

- Drag a rectangle on photo to select the face and shoulders, Then click Crop Selection

- Set width 150 and height to 200 pixels

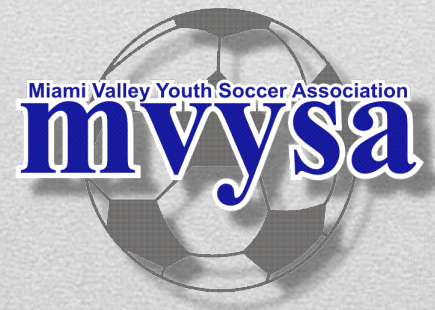
