## SWIMMING AND DIVING GUIDELINES

- 1. A student may participate in a total of four (4) events, two of which must be relays
- 2. Coed Swim scores will be combined between all grades to determine the City Championship
- 3. Swimmers are allowed to swim in two (2) exhibition events in the championship meet
- 4. Diving takes place prior to the start of the meet or on an alternate date if necessary.
- 5. Swimming and Diving programs are considered cooperative programs.
- 6. Location of practices will be City MS/HS, Ottawa Hills, and/or Union
