#### **Competition Breakdown**

<u>Cheer Clinic:</u> Postponed -This clinic is for both Coaches and Players

## 1st Showcase: 12-10-19 5:15pm at City MS/HS Upper Gym

The showcase will include the precision 10 count cheer, 1<sup>st</sup> Cheer/Round 2. Both 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade teams will perform.

## 2nd Showcase: 01-09-20 5:15pm at City MS/HS Upper Gym

The 2<sup>nd</sup> showcase will include the precision 10 count cheer, 1<sup>st</sup> Cheer/Round 2 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Cheer/Round 3 cheer. Both 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade teams will perform.

## City Wide Championship: 01-30-20 5:15 at City MS/HS Upper Gym

The championship round will include two rounds. All teams will perform the precision 10 count cheer, 1<sup>st</sup> Cheer/Round 2 and then perform 2<sup>nd</sup> Cheer/Round.

\*\*If additional competition opportunities become available they will be offered to teams on a first come, first serve basis.\*\*

All showcases and the final competition will be judged according to the MHSAA guidelines and by MHSAA certified safety and panel judges.

- Each middle school program and cooperative program have the opportunity to have a competitive cheer team representing their school during the season.
- Middle school rounds consist of only a Required 10 Count Round and an Open Round.
- During competition a minimum of four and a maximum of 16 team members are allowed on the floor for competition in either round.
