## Westside Football Classic & Midwest Football Classic Tournament Code of Conduct

To ensure everyone has a wonderful time during the tournament event, the Board of Directors have created a Team Code of Conduct Agreement to establish guidelines for coaches, players and spectators in attendance. Reading, understanding, and agreeing to the Conduct Agreement is required for attendance for each team.

- 1. As head coach (team listed below) I will take full responsibility for all my players, coaches, and spectators while at any of the tournaments events and while on hotel property. To the best of my ability I will be responsible for my team followers during tournament events.
- 2. Kids and team must respect hotel property and valuables. Some of the hotels may require a small damage deposit. If there is damage to a particular room, the card that the room was reserved under may be subject to being charged for the damage. Make sure the kids are supervised at all times. The hotels do understand that it is tough escorting many kids in and out of the hotels to the games and events and they know it's not going to be a silent affair but just please be aware of the noise level.
- 3. Everyone on my roster is within the age requirements of the division that I have entered my team. Every player has proper identification (birth certificates). I understand we will be removed from competition immediately and never allowed admittance into these events again if we are found to be using an ineligible player. No refund will be given.
- 4. I have advised my players, coaches and team followers to be on there best behavior and reminded the adults that this event is for the kids and for all to be great role models and examples.
