The Format:

- Highest fundraising team to attend Red Sox game at Fenway. Second highest fundraising team to attend minor league game. See <u>Online Site</u> for more details and ideas on fundraising!
- Fund Raising should be sent in no later than August 17th to Teresa Kane. c/o Jimmy Fund 10 Brookline Place West | Brookline, MA 02445-7226), Make sure include LL District 13 & Team name/Division Donation checks should be made out to Jimmy Fund Dana Farber
- Hats/Visors provided by Jimmy Fund to be worn by all teams. More than 14 players are allowed per team to accommodate sign-ups & vacation schedules
- Have <u>FUN</u> and remember in this program, everyone wins!
- Unless noted, starting time is 5:45. Visiting team to contact opposing Coach for field location and directions. Make-ups for rainouts can be made up within the same week (Mon-Sun). Both teams to agree on date. Home team will schedule and pay the umpires. Two are preferable.
- Rotating batting order including all players who attend. A late arrival may be added to the end of the order only. Free substitution. Eight players are required to begin the game; the ninth spot in the order will be an out.
- Three outs or six run limit end the inning, except in the final inning, which could be earlier than the sixth due to weather or darkness.
- Standard LL pitching rules apply. Baseball Pitch count & days rest rule to be followed Reminder LL Rule...NO On Deck batters in these divisions
- 7-8 level only: No stealing home allowed. Once a player arrives safely at third base, they must remain on third base until either forced home by a walk or by advancing during a play that begins with a ball hit into play. The only exception is that if a base runner attempts to steal 3rd and the defensive team makes an errant throw to 3rd base, the base runner may continue home should he choose to do so. This division is player & coach pitch (if needed).
- <u>All teams who raise \$500 or more make the Playoffs</u>, scheduled for the week of July 27-August 3 (East), single elimination. Coin toss will determine the home team.
