ST. JOSEPH CYO PARENTAL AGREEMENT

- 1. My child is eligible to play because he/she either: (1) attends St. Joseph School, (2) is enrolled in St. Joseph's Faith Formation, or (3) resides in the parish's boundaries, which are: north of Scott Creek Road, East of the Union Pacific railroad tracks, south of Stevenson.
- I understand that if there is a need to create more than one team, teams will be formed following a player evaluation. The American team is formed first, then one or more National teams can be formed. I understand that there is no guarantee that players will be placed with former teammates or former coaches.
- 3. I understand that restrooms will be open during games and practices. I will instruct my child/children to properly use and to respect the facilities. I understand that CYO is a guest at the facilities, and it is my responsibility to help ensure that the program is able to continue using the facilities by using the locations responsibly.
- 4. I understand we use gyms of other schools and I will instruct my child/children to respect those schools' facilities. No sports drinks, WATER ONLY, at practice & games.
- 5. If my child wants to wear a t-shirt under the uniform, it is my responsibility to obtain a t-shirt of the same basic color as the predominate color of the jersey. Royal Blue is our dominant color. If an alternate color is worn, the referee could ask the child to remove the undershirt.
- 6. When children are dropped off at practice, parents are to make sure that their child's coach is at the gym before the parent leaves. No parent is to leave a child until after the coach arrives. Parents must pick up their child. Children are not to walk or ride a bike home. If a parent wants their child to walk or ride a bike home, the parent is to provide St. Joseph CYO with a letter stating that and releasing CYO from responsibility.
- 7. I understand that parents and family members are welcome to come to practices and watch, but non-CYO players are not permitted to use the gym during a team's practice and may not stay at practice without a parent or guardian. This includes siblings.
- 8. I understand that I can encourage and work with my child at home, but during practices and games, I may not coach my child unless I am a coach with a coach's card.
- 9. I understand and agree that Coaches coach, players play, and parents and fans cheer positively and support good play by both teams and will act accordingly at games.
- 10. I understand water is the only thing that may be brought into the gym during practice, and/or game gym. NO food, coffee, sodas, or sport drinks are allowed in public school gyms. If a gym has an open snackbar, the rules of that gym apply. (HS, MCHS)
- 11. I will cheer positively for good play by all players. Players, parents, and fans MAY NOT heckle, jeer, or taunt refs, coaches, players or other fans. I will allow the players to play, the coaches to coach, and the officials to officiate. [Coaches, parents and spectators have been ejected from games for not following these rules.]
- 12. Good sportsmanship is one of the values we are to model for our participants. Positive cheering for all players is encouraged. Remember, today's opponent may be tomorrow's teammate.
- 13. I will set a good example and inform any guest I bring to my child's game of the Code of Conduct and the requirement to respect other players, coaches, fans and officials.
- 14. I understand that it is my responsibility to inform any guest or family member that attends my child's game of the CYO Code of Conduct and that all spectators are to respect all players, coaches, officials and other spectators at the game.
- 15. I understand that everyone in St. Joseph's CYO is a volunteer, no one is paid. All volunteers are here to see that all children have a positive experience. If at any time, a child or parent has concerns about refs, coaches, players, opponents, they should first contact their coach, or go to their Athletic Director. Do NOT contact REFS, OPPOSING COACHES, OR OFFICIALS on game day. Contact PARISH CYO OFFICIALS.
- 16. Parental Support: We need active parental participation of all parents in our program and our league to make it successful. Please contact us about volunteering for a CYO parish or league position. Coach, Coach Mgr, Equipment Mgr, Uniform Mgr, Treasurer, Scheduler, Awards Mgr, Photo Day Mgr, etc.
