Annual field maintenance day will be announced later. All families are encouraged to help at their local field. We need help at all the fields in the league: Laurium Gipp Fields, Ahmeek, Lake Linden Village Park and the Boneyard.

Divisions in KLL

<u>Jr. Coach Pitch: Players ages 5-6.</u> Players learn to throw, catch, and hit a ball. Players will get 3 pitches from a coach and then hit off a tee. 2 games/practices per week (Tuesdays & Thursdays).

<u>Machine Pitch: Players ages 7-8.</u> Players hit a machine-pitched ball. 2 games/practices per week (Wednesdays & Fridays).

<u>Minor League Baseball: Players ages 9-10.</u> Players begin pitching in this league and continue skill development. 3 games/practices per week (Monday, Wednesday, & Saturdays). These are New Nights for this division!

<u>Little League Baseball: Hardball, players ages 11-12.</u> Players will play 3 games/practices per week (Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays).

<u>Minor/Major Girls Softball: Ages 8-12</u>. Players will be divided into divisional teams based on ability and skill level. By keeping players of similar levels together, we are able to develop and work on areas of the game specific to each player. Players begin pitching in the minor league level. Games played Mondays & Wednesdays, skill sessions on Saturdays.

<u>Senior/Junior Softball: Girls ages 13-16</u>. Games played Mondays & Wednesdays, skill sessions on Saturdays.

<u>Senior/Junior Baseball: Boys ages 13-16</u>. Games are played in Kearsarge, Houghton, Hancock, Dollar Bay, Greenland, and Baraga. When scheduling, we work around school schedule and all large field schedules.

Other League Info

Fee usage: Player and sponsor fees are used for uniforms, balls, equipment, printing, umpires, league insurance, field maintenance, and tournament-hosting events. Coaches and volunteers are needed for all divisions. Too busy to take on coaching? Please offer to help as an umpire, field maintenance, league official, or to fill in as needed.
