Code of Conduct

This code is based on the mission of BRW Softball to provide a well-organized, supportive youth softball program where girls have an enjoyable experience playing softball, learning softball skills and life lessons, and building lifelong friendships in a positive and nurturing environment.

- This Code applies to all BRW players (travel and rec), family members, guests and coaches
- \circ Win or lose, enjoy the experience of actively participating in softball whether travel or rec
- o Always show respect to teammates, coaches, opposing teams & umpires
- No profanity or inappropriate behavior, including threatening anyone at a BRW event
- o No harassment, including any form of sexual harassment
- No coaching by non-coach family members or guests at BRW practices or games unless requested by the team's coach.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs are allowed at BRW events except for alcohol for of-age family members, guests and coaches and only at facilities that permit alcohol
- o No spending of BRW team money or use of BRW property for personal purposes
- If any Blast coach, player, family member, or guest is ejected from a game, one of the Blast Board members must be notified within 48 hours by the Blast coach and consequences, including possible expulsion from the Blast, will be assessed in a timely manner.
- Parents/guardians may not approach a coach during or immediately after a game with a concern. Parents/guardians wishing to discuss a concern with a coach, must wait until at least 24 hours after a game, and must do so in a calm manner. Remember that your coach is balancing team and player development with winning.
- All violations of the above will have consequences at coach's and/or BRW Board's discretion, which may include benching, suspension, and expulsion.
- This Code applies to all visiting coaches and players, and their family members and guests at BRW fields.
