All-Star Draft Details

Manager

- The Manager of the regular season's division champion shall be All-Star Manager.
- Should this manager reject the position, it shall be offered to the manager of the next winningest team until a Manager accepts the position.
- If all managers reject the position, each Manager/Coach shall elect the Manager.

Manager & Assistant Coach Eligibility

- Each officially rostered, regular season Manager and Assistant Coach (Furthermore referred to collectively as Manager/Coach) are eligible to participate in the All-Star Draft and to represent the All-Star team as a Manager/Coach.
- Each Manager/Coach has one (1) vote, all votes carry equal weight, no vote may be transferred, and voters must cast their vote, physically, in person. No one else shall have the power to vote. Managers/Coaches may abstain from voting on their own volition.
- Coach Pitch teams and below shall have one (1) Manager and three (3) Assistant Coaches.
- Kid-Pitch teams shall have one (1) Manager and two (2) Assistant Coaches.

Athlete Eligibility

- Prior to making selections, athletes and their parents must:
 - Be made aware of and then commit to providing documentation to verify eligibility as required by franchise.
 - Be made aware of schedule for practices and tournaments and commit to attendance. According to franchise rules, a rostered athlete can miss no part of tournaments without penalizing their team.
 - Be made aware of and then commit to paying any necessary fees.
 - An athlete unable to make these commitments shall not be selected.
 - Only parents/athletes agreeing to these terms shall be considered for All-Stars.
- The above criteria will provide each Manager/Coach with a list of all athletes and their eligibility/desire to be a part of the All-Star Team. This list shall be communicated to all the other Managers/Coaches before drafting so only draft-eligible athletes receive votes.
- At times, TBSL and LYB (Lovelady) have had separate teams for the regular season but combined for the postseason. Upon the close of regular season registration, TBSL and LYB shall together determine whether both leagues will combine for 1 team or if each league will take a team. This decision will be for all divisions.
- Because the TBSL and LYB combine to play their regular season, the boundary for their combined league shall be that of the Trinity Independent School District and Lovelady Independent School District. Athletes must live within these boundaries or the athlete must be a student of TISD or LISD to be eligible for All-Stars.
- Athletes must have been rostered with TBSL or LYB, respectively, for the regular season.

Process for Selection of Athletes

- TBSL shall give forty-eight (48) hours notice to the Managers/Coaches so that as many as possible may participate in the selection process.
 - A quorum is required and so if a quorum is not present, reschedule the meeting for the following day. Repeat as necessary until a quorum is present.
- TBSL shall provide a place for the Managers/Coaches to meet for selection process and a TBSL Director shall be available to conduct the draft.
- TBSL shall communicate the required number of athletes range according to the franchise (Dixie) rules so that the appropriate number of athletes are selected. Prior to the draft, all Coaches/Managers shall collectively agree on the number of athletes within that range that will represent the team.
- Each manager and coach shall use this number to comprise a list of athletes they believe deserves to make the team. The listing shall be in no particular order.
- Once each manager and coach have finished their list, the TBSL Director conducting the draft shall total the number of times each athlete appears across all lists.
 - Athletes with the most appearances across all lists shall comprise the team.
 - If the team is incomplete after the initial vote, the Managers/Coaches shall make a new list for the remaining spots.
 - Should a tie result in more athletes being selected for the team than there are spots for, only those who were tied shall be voted on again.
 - Only the number of athletes needed to complete the team shall be selected.
 - Example: Coaches decide to take twelve (12) athletes: ten (10) make every coaches' list, six (6) tie for the second-most votes, three (3) tie for third-most, and seven (7) receive one (1) vote. The then (10) athletes with the most votes are on the team. Only the six (6) with the second-most votes are eligible for the two (2) remaining spots. The two (2) names that appear most in the re-vote will fill the final two (2) spots.
- If following the draft, any of the athletes are unable to play for any reason, the All-Star coaching staff shall select an eligible athlete of their choosing to fill in as the alternate.

Process for Selection of Assistant Coaches

- Only upon completion of the draft, all Managers/Coaches shall select the coaching staff. This helps us select the players that should represent the team rather than selecting players in order to have their parent coach the team.
- All regular season Managers and Assistant Coaches are eligible to be Assistant Coaches unless they remove themselves as a candidate.
- Remembering that coach pitch teams and below shall have three (3) Assistant Coaches and kid-pitch teams shall have two (2) Assistant Coaches, only that number shall be voted on.
- The format shall follow the draft for the athletes.
