## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### ANSWER

Registration is available through our website by clicking the "Sign up here" button, which will prompt you to login/create an account. Registration opened in February and closed on March 26th. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate latecomers. We need to allow printing time for jerseys, as well as create rosters, assign coaches, and schedule practices.

## ANSWER

Some, yes. AYL provides all players with a gameday shirt (Tee-ball) or jersey (Rookies, Minors, Majors) and hat (baseball) or visor (softball). Players are responsible for the rest of their unforms. Socks should be navy blue. You will need to have a properly fitting baseball glove. Each team has access to equipment, such as bats and helmets, but you can certainly use your own equipment, so long as it meets the Babe Ruth/Cal Ripken standards

## ANSWER

Yes. Picture Day will be held on May 22nd at Jones Field. If you choose to purchase photos, you will be required to pay the photographer that day, but pictures will be sent home with players typically a couple weeks later. Even if you are not purchasing a player picture, we would ask that you show up for

Your coach will provide a schedule once they are finalized. Home games will be played on one of the 3 fields located at "Little Fenway"/Jones Field off Letter S Road in Alton. (Your coach will tell you which field you will play on based on which program you are in.) Away game field locations and directions can be found on our website under the "Locations" tab. Game schedules can be viewed under the "Schedules" tab on our website.

#### ANSWER
