Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How will I know a spot has been reserved for me?

A. A confirmation email will be sent as soon as your application is processed. All necessary details and camp information (what to bring, registration information, directions, transportation services, medical forms, etc.) will be emailed to you.

Q. Can parents or coaches come to watch sessions?

A. Yes, all sessions are open and we encourage parents and coaches to visit. Copies of the curriculum are always available.

Q. Does the camp provide education regarding college recruitment?

A. At the Carolina Soccer School ID & Skills Camp, campers benefit from our College Recruiting Panel featuring college coaches and current college players. The college recruiting process and opportunities in collegiate soccer are discussed and questions are encouraged.

Q. How do I get to camp? Is there an airport shuttle?

A. The Carolina Soccer Schools are located on the U.S.C. campus in Columbia, SC. Columbia Metropolitan Airport is located 15 minutes from campus. Shuttle service can be purchased through the soccer school for \$10.

Q. Are teams welcome?

A. Teams are welcome at all sessions. There will be a team discount of \$25/camper, at all overnight camps for teams with 8 or more. Teams of 5 or more will be eligible for a discount of \$10/camper at the Half Day camp and \$15/camper at the Full Day camp. *All team members must register* together with the team registration form. Please contact Mat Cosgriff at mcosgriff@sc.edu for information regarding team registration.

Q. Are commuters welcome at the overnight camps?

A. Commuters are welcome at all overnight camps. Commuter discounts are listed for each camp session.

Q. How do camp discounts work?

A. There are two types of discounts – **Individual** discounts and **Team** discounts. If you register before the early registration date as an **individual** then you are eligible for the early registration discount. If you are registering with a **team** then you will receive the team discount. Only one discount can be applied per camper. The commuter discount takes precedence over all other discounts.

This ID & Skills camp will feature some of the top high school aged players from around the country. Our goal is to simulate a top collegiate level training environment. Campers will be challenged both mentally and physically over the 4 days of camp. There will be a focus on "match plaving" between the camp teams including 11 v 11 and 6 v 6 small sided tournaments. The emphasis will be placed on group and team tactics Campers will be put in problem solving situations where their individual tactical ability and technical skills will be challenged There will be an All - Star match that will feature the top 30 campers. Campers will receive two T-shirts and a camp ball.

The ID Goalkeeper Academy is designed for the GK that is looking to be pushed to their limit. Each session will be both physically and mentally demanding and will help GKs evaluate their strengths and weaknesses. Goalkeepers will be introduced to instructional practice sessions that will include the following topics: footwork, shot stopping, dealing with crosses and service, 1v1 situations. A unique advantage to this camp is that it is run in conjunction with the ID & Advanced Skills field player camp. This gives the goalkeepers the opportunity to apply and practice their refinements in daily 6 v 6 and 11 v 11 competitions. A thorough GK specific evaluation will be given to every GK at the end of camp. In addition, campers will also receive a camp GK training shirt, camp T shirt and a camp ball.

USC strength and conditioning staff will provide an instructional session for the campers. An instructional guide will be provided. College coaches will be on site by visiting Division II and III schools throughout the duration of camp and a writ-

There will be an All -Star match that will feature the top 30 campers.

The Level II Skills Goalkeeper Academy offers a highly competitive training atmosphere for goalkeepers to refine their technical skills and be challenged in tactical game related situations. Goalkeepers will be introduced to instructional practice sessions that will include the following topics: footwork, shot stopping, dealing with crosses and service, 1v1 situations, and distribution. The Level II Skills GK camp is run in conjunction with the Level II Skills Training field player camps. This gives the goalkeepers the opportunity to apply and practice their refinements in daily 6 v 6 and 11 v 11 com petitions. A thorough GK specific evaluation will be given to every GK at the end of camp. In addition, campers will also receive a camp GK training shirt and a camp ball.
