President's Report, submitted by Josh Fishel:

 - The small bags will be given to all coaches to take to away games.
 - The large bags will stay at each field for home games.
- Uniform list information

 - SGBA owes 25 8UB&C players \$35 for uniforms
 - 4 10U players owe SGBA \$35 for uniforms
 - 6 12U players owe SGBA \$35 for uniforms
 - 2 16-19 players owe SGBA \$35 for uniforms

Fields and Grounds Director, submitted by Damian Sipe:

- Damian reviewed summary of costs and savings from donations.

- Thank you to all who helped with the fields.
- Jefferson – still need 1 load of Diamond Tex at approximately \$1400 – all approved
 - Moving L-screen and digout tool from SG boro to Jefferson
 - Will remove trash from sheds and then concrete the floor
- St Rose of Lima – the school will allow us to use 1-2 fields. 8U and teeball can use the small field. We will plan to use the larger field in the future.
 - Remember – on Sundays we cannot start practice/games until after 1pm
 - Benches need fixed
- NC – Leaves need cleaned up. Plan for cleanup on 4/7.
- SG Boro – Bus garage possibly used for batting cage and pitching. Will ask and determine this in the future.
- Heidelberg – Damian will check back in with Heidelberg in July because there will be new leadership.
- Email to be sent out for donations of tractors to drag fields at NC and Jefferson.

Open Floor:

- Opening Day scheduled for April 15 at Jefferson field starting at 9am (all board members are to arrive by 7:30am)
 - 8U & 10U scrimmages to be scheduled on the mid field
 - Teeball scrimmages to be scheduled on the upper field
 - 35+ scrimmage on the big field
 - Need signup sheet for concession donations – Jen to do
 - Small game of chance items to be purchased
 - HS players to help with directing parking
 - Will kick off opening day with national anthem and announcing all players on the field
 - The youngest player will throw the first pitch of the season to the oldest player
 - The board decided not to have picture taken during opening day and will use the company that the school uses – Josh to coordinate
 - Jon K – to reach out to Kona Ice
 - Mike F – provide drone to take pics
- Mike N. mentioned that there is no tee at NC Upper
- Mike N. also mentioned that some parents are concerned with no communication for 8U yet. That is because teams were just formed tonight and coaches will be reaching out soon.
