Coleman-Pound Little League Sign up for 11-12U League, 9-10U League and 6-8 U (Machine Pitch League)

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR 2021! (CLOSED AS OF 3/17/2021)

Head to https://clubs.bluesombrero.com/colemanpound and click on "Register" on the upper right hand side of the page. You are able to enter your child or children here. All transactions are completed via credit/debit card.

Players must be between the ages of 6 and 12 as of April 30th. Coaches would like to keep players in their age appropriate league, but may need to move players up if the age group ahead needs players to fill their team. All teams travel to Crivitz, County Line, Wausaukee and Lena for games. Home games are at Equity Park, the Village of Pound field and also the Village of Coleman field.

<u>Handout Dates:</u> Usually we meet in person to handout fundraising materials, hats, socks, pants, and also your clothing order. This meeting date is not set currently; we will pass this date and time along once it is set (typically at one of the practices). Fees: Fees for playing in the league will be \$22.00 per child plus a small transaction fee. Each child is required to purchase a Coleman-Pound baseball hat and a pair of baseball socks.

Costs: Baseball hat: \$18.00, Game Socks: \$7.00, 9-12U player's jersey \$35.00 +- (only if needed)

Sign Up fee: \$22.00 sign up per child + \$3.00 transaction fee

NOTE:

*6-8 year olds will need to purchase a hat and socks (if you don't already own these). Uniforms will be provided by the club.

*9 through 12 year olds will need to purchase a hat, socks and jersey. Black pants will be supplied by the club or you may purchase your own. Additionally, all bats used must be USA stamped. This is a mandated league rule.

Fundraiser: We will be doing a different fundraiser this year selling hand braided pastries. Each pastry costs \$14.00 each. With each pastry sale, parents will receive a \$2.50 cutback to go towards offsetting your league costs. Selling period is April 7th through April 23rd. All pastry orders will arrive at the Pound baseball field for pickup on May 6th from 2:45 PM to 5:45 PM. Orders are done and paid online. Interested parties are also able to use a hard copy signup and would be responsible for payment at the time the selling period is over.

Practice

Below are the practice dates and times for all levels; please read carefully.

<u>6-8U:</u> Practices will be Mondays and Wednesdays, at Equity Park and the Coleman field. Two teams will practice at Coleman and one will be at Equity. Locations will ROTATE so note this below. Games typically start the third week of May through the month of June and are on Mondays and Wednesdays at 5:30 pm unless otherwise noted. Please arrive at the field in full uniform by 5:00 for warm ups.

6-8U PRACTICE: 5:30 – 6:30 PM: (Mondays and Wednesdays @ EQUITY PARK and COLEMAN)

NOTE: Please note below teams are at certain fields for practice.

April 19 & April 21: Teams 1 and 2 are at Coleman; Team 3 is at Equity.

April 26 & April 28: Teams 1 and 3 are at Coleman; Team 2 is at Equity.

May 3 & May 5: Teams 2 and 3 are at Coleman; Team 1 is at Equity.

May 10 & May 12: Teams 1 and 2 are at Coleman; Team 3 is at Equity.

9-10U: Practices will be Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Pound field. 9-10U game schedule typically starts the third week of May thru June. Games are Mondays and Wednesdays at 5:30 p.m. unless otherwise noted. Please arrive at the field by 5:00 for warm ups.

9-10U PRACTICE: 5:30 – 6:45 PM: (Tuesdays and Thursdays @ POUND)

<u>11-12U:</u> Practices will be Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Coleman Field. 11-12U games typically start the third week of May and run through June. Games are Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:30 p.m. unless otherwise noted. Please arrive to field by 5:00 for warm ups.

11-12U PRACTICE: 5:30 – 6:45 PM: (Tuesdays and Thursdays @ COLEMAN)

April 20 & April 22 April 27 & April 29 May 4 & May 6 May 11 & May 13

<u>Attire for practice</u>: Please dress your child for the weather. Please wear tennis shoes/cleats, a baseball hat and bring a glove to practice.

<u>IMPORTANT EQUIPMENT NOTE:</u> All bats in 9-10U and 11-12U must be **USA stamped** (See the stamp below, bats would have this just below the grip). All other bats are considered illegal by league rule; bats are checked by umpires.



League Tournament & Game Schedule:

6-8U: @ Lena on June 26th

9-10U: @ Wausaukee on June 18-19

11-12U: @ Wausaukee on June 18-19 (11-12U will also have a four team playoff at the end of the season)

All players and teams are expected to participate in these tournaments.

<u>Uniforms</u>: All players will have their uniforms prior to the first baseball game. At the conclusion of the baseball season, uniforms will be collected (players keep their hats and socks in all levels, players in 9-10U and 11-12U will also keep their jerseys). If you cannot attend, please schedule a time to meet me or your respective coach to turn in uniforms.

<u>Pictures:</u> We will have individual and team pictures; the time and date is to be determined and shared as soon as possible.

<u>Concession Stand Volunteer:</u> The concession stand is our largest fundraiser for the club. Again this year we will be utilizing SignUpGenius for our concession stand volunteers. SignupGenius allows you to pick your date(s) online and a reminder will be emailed to you a few days before the event. This program is fast and easy to use. We will be sending out a link to SignUpGenius once we have our game schedule complete.

We require each player's parent(s) to register for at least one spot during the season. If you would like to watch your son/daughter play and not work during their game, sign up for another slot and/or even a night when a different league is playing. We typically have around 40 games to schedule, so this is extremely important. Volunteers in the concession stand must be a minimum of 16 year or above.

Please note other clubs ask for a volunteer deposit, which would be refunded at the end of the baseball program, if volunteer hours were met. The Coleman Little League would like to avoid this policy. If a volunteer is not signed up by the due date, you will be entered into the first available spot that is open and required to work or find a replacement for that given day. We rely on your support to keep the program funded, thank you for volunteering!!!
