Frequently Asked Questions

Registration Questions

Q: When is Registration for the Arlington NFL Flag Football League?

A: Regular Registration opens 12 AM on Monday July 6, 2020 through Monday July 20, 2020

Late Registration is from July 21st until July 31st. Late registration Fee is \$15

Registration Closes 11:59 PM on July 31st

Q: Where can I register?

A: The link for online registration can be found <u>HERE</u>. Walk-up registrations are currently unavailable. You may call 703-228-4747 for registration assistance.

Q: Do I need to create an account?

A: Many of you may already have an account from the old Stack Sports system and might just need to activate it from your email. Those that don't, will need to register as a new user and have an email to verify it upon registration.

Payment Questions

Q: What is the fee for playing in the league?

A: The registration fee is \$90.00. Included with your registration fee is an NFL team jersey, and flags





for each player. There is a \$15 late fee for registrations received after July 20th

Q: How can I pay for the league?

The building is closed to the public, but you can use the drop box on the S. Nelson St. Entrance. Mail is being checked once per week, so there may be some delay in processing.

Q: Do fee reductions apply to the Arlington Flag Football League?

A: Yes, Income-Based fee reductions are available for Arlington residents in all Arlington County programs, including Financial Hardship Rates. Details are available <u>here</u>. Call 703-228-4747 to get further help if needed. A fee adjustment needs to be done over the phone, so please call before processing pay.

League or Schedule Questions

Q: How long is the season?

- A: Practices begin the week of August 22nd.
- Regular season games begin September 12th -13th
- The season ends the weekend of the November 14th and 15th.

Q: Do we play on holiday weekends?

A: Yes, we play on Columbus, Veterans, and Halloween Weekend

Q: Where are the games and practices? How many times do we play per week?





A: Most activities will take place at Barcroft Park, Bluemont Park, Ft. Barnard, Kenmore Middle School, Quincy Park, Wakefield High School, and Washington-Liberty High School. Teams are assigned two practices weekly in the preseason, one weekday practice and one weekend game in the regular season.

Q: How many games are in a season?

A: The regular season consists of 7 games and is followed by a single elimination tournament that will end no later than November 14-15.

Player or Team Questions

Q: I've never played in the Flag Football league; how do I join a team?

A: Players are assigned to teams by school affiliation. You can also request to play with friends,

request coaches or teams in the "Special Request" section on the online registration form.

Q: I've played Arlington NFL Flag Football in the past, will I be placed on the same team?

A: You have an option to be assigned to your team from the previous season. If it is not indicated on your registration form, you will be assigned to a team based on school affiliation.

Q: Is the Arlington Flag Football league open to non-Arlington residents?

A: The Flag Football league is open to Arlington County residents-only.

Q: What age is the league for?

A: *is for players entering Fall 2020 Grades* 1^{*st*}-12^{*th*}. *Players are able to play up* 1 *division, but not down a division*.

Q: How many players are on one team?

A: Rosters cannot exceed 12 players per team to ensure maximum playing time for all players.

Q: How long are Flag Football games and practices?





A: All Flag Football Activities are approximately one-hour. The game is two 24-minute halves.

Volunteer or Other Questions

Q: I would like to coach this year. What do I need to do?

A: Awesome! And Thanks. Coaches will need to login/create an account and access the volunteer tab on their account page.
