# **Program History**

- Program entering 14<sup>th</sup> year
  - Affiliated with NFL Flag Football
- Among the largest DPR Administered Youth Sports
  - 1300+ participants and 114 teams in 2019
  - One of the nation's largest NFL Flag programs
- Fastest Growing Youth Sport in Arlington County
- Defending 2020 13/14U National Champions





# **Team Formation**

- Team rosters consist of 10-12 players (may expand upon coach request)
- Players requested specific team/coach at time of registration
  - Preference given to returning players from 2019 season
- Players without requests will be placed on teams based on school/location when possible
- Team rosters released to coaches August 26
- Coach notifies players of placement by August 28
- All players must play equal amounts of time

### League Information

- September 14th- November 15th
- League Divisions

•Coed Leagues - Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9-12 •Girls Leagues - Grades 6-8 and 9-12

- Players can play a division up
- Registration Fee includes NFL jersey, flag belt, and team footballs
- Starting with Practices Only

- Aligns with VHSL
- Focus on skills and safety
- Formed with child mental and physical well-being in mind





#### Coronavirus **Guidelines-Entry/Exit**

- Before Arrival
  - Self-assess symptoms
  - Take temperature
- Equipment
  - Label & Secure in a bag
- Park Entry
  - Stay away until start time
  - Allow for field to clear
  - Masks Required
- Practice Check-in
  - Attendance taken
  - Health Screening Questions ullet

#### **Coronavirus Guidelines-Football Activity**

- Maintain Social distancing during meetings and drills
- Coaches wear masks
- COVID-Coach required on-site
  - Must be different than Head Coach
- Sanitation of shared equipment between drills
- No Scrimmages or Game-like scenarios that do not allow for social distancing
- Mouthguards
- Fans will be limited to 2 guardians per child

# Coaching

- Volunteer Coaches
- COVID Coach
  - Responsible for health screening check-in
  - Responsible for sanitation of shared equipment
  - Responsible for helping maintaining social distancing
  - Does not need to be the same person but must be registered and background checked.
- No experience necessary
- Interested individuals should register online





## Practices

- Practice Request Forms sent to coaches via email on August 26
- Forms due to DPR scheduling by 5:00pm on Monday, September 2
- Permits sent to coaches via email by COB on Friday, September 11
- Practices begin on Monday, September 14
- Coaches may request a change in day between preseason and regular season
  - Will attempt to accommodate





## Practices

- Equipment Requirements
  - Mouthguards required
  - Shorts with no pockets or taped pockets
  - Personal Equipment needs to be sanitized prior to shared use.
- Weather Alert Line
  - 703-228-4715
  - Sign-up for Text Updates with <u>Arlington Alert</u>
- Playing Time
  - All players must practice equal amounts of time
  - Players should have an opportunity to learn different positions. This model is a great opportunity for players to learn/try new positions.
