#### **Program History**

- Program entering 20<sup>th</sup> year
  - Among the largest DPR Administered Youth Sports
  - One of the nation's largest NFL Flag programs
    - 1,300+ players this season
    - 130 teams
    - 242 Girls





#### League Information

- League Divisions
  - Coed Divisions Grades 1,2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9-10 & 11-12
  - Girls Divisions Grades 5-6, 7-8, 9-10 & 11-12
  - Divisions split based on size & competitive level
- Players may play up, but not down
- Players may only play on one team per division
- Practices Begin Week of August 19<sup>th</sup>
- Games Begin Weekend of September 7<sup>th</sup>
  - 7 Scheduled Regular Season Games (6 Guaranteed) and at least 1 Playoff Game
- Single Elimination Playoffs Begin October 26th & 27th
- Playoffs Conclude November 3rd (11/9-10 Makeup Weekend)





#### **Team Rosters**

- Team rosters consist of 10 players
  - Coaches may request more
    - Those coaches must make their team aware of carrying over the maximum
- Players requested specific teammate/coach at time of registration
  - Attempt to honor all requests
  - Players without requests assigned to teams based on school/neighborhood





#### LIGHTNING SAFETY

WHEN THUNDER IS HEARD, OR A CLOUD-TO-GROUND LIGHTNING BOLT IS SEEN

#### SUSPEND PLAY AND TAKE SHELTER IMMEDIATELY

PRESS BOXES, SHEDS, STORAGE BUILDINGS, OR DUGOUTS WILL NOT PROVIDE ADEQUATE PROTECTION.

30/30 RULE OR THIRTY-MINUTE RULE

WAIT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES AFTER THE LAST THUNDER IS HEARD OR FLASH OF LIGHTNING PRIOR TO RESUMING PLAY.

ANY SUBSEQUENT THUNDER OR LIGHTNING AFTER RESETS THE CLOCK FOR ANOTHER 30-MINUTE DLEAY




## **Flag 101**

Penalties Chart 2024 Rule Book

#### **Arlington County Rule Modifications**


- All forward passes must be received beyond the line of scrimmage
- Fumbles are Dead Balls
- Must be behind the rush line at snap\*
- Rushing the Passer (Rule 8.5)
- No Run Zones\*
- 2 60 second Timeouts per game
- 24-minute halves running clock\*
- 40 second play clock
- Coaches on the field (1-3)
- Overtime Format





#### **New Rules**

- Pitches, laterals, and backwards passes are permitted behind the line of scrimmage only
- Rushers must now identify themselves by raising their hand pre-snap. Maximum of 2 rushers per play
- Rush MUST be immediate. NO delayed rushing permitted.
- Any time prior to making the ball ready for play on 4th down, the referee must ask the coach to declare "PUNT or PLAY". The coach must answer or risk a delay of game penalty at that time
- Jumping and leaping is not permitted.





#### Season Standings

- Winning Coaches Report Scores through the Score Reporting Form within 24 hours.
- Divisional Tiebreakers:
  - Winning %
  - Head-to-Head
  - Record vs. Common opponents
  - Points against
  - Rock, Paper, Scissors via email
- All Teams make the playoffs
- Teams may be moved for playoffs

- Background Check Process
  - Employer's Choice
    - Not needed, if done in the past 8 months
  - CDC Heads Up Training
- Sports Connect
  - Team Central
  - Stack Team App
- Coaches Code of Conduct
