The Highline Soccer Association (HSA) is proud to offer five (5) scholarship awards for the 2023-2024 academic year to assist our graduating high school players in pursuing post-high school education starting in Fall 2024. These scholarship awards are funded through a generous donation from Tom Clayton and player fees assessed to our Member Clubs.

Scholarship Awards

• First Place: \$1,500 awarded to a single outstanding applicant

Second Place: \$750 awarded to two (2) applicants

• Third Place: \$500 awarded to two (2) applicants

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have played soccer for a minimum of two (2) seasons with any club or team in the Highline Soccer Association (Highline Soccer Club, West Seattle Soccer Club, HSA Select, or Highline Premier FC).
- 2. Graduate from an accredited high school at the end of the 2023-2024 school year.
- 3. Plan to attend university, community college, or accredited vocational/trade school in Fall 2024.

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit the following materials:

- Completed application form (attached)
- Personal essay (500-word maximum) describing your involvement in soccer, academic achievements, and future goals.

Application Deadline and Submission

- Complete applications must be submitted by Saturday, April 20, 2024.
- Late applications will not be considered.
