Game Day – Field Prep: These parents will arrive at the games early. You will coordinate the time needed to begin field prep with your head coach. Field prep includes raking the field, preparing the pitcher's mound, laying chalk lines, preparing the dugouts, and more.

Game Day – Clean Up: These parents will stay after the games and restore the facilities to close the fields. These duties include dumping the garbage cans on your field, raking the fields, returning any equipment to the sheds, cleaning/locking dugouts, and locking gates if you are the last team on your side of the road.

Game Day Snack Coordinator: This parent will use the game schedule to create a list of volunteers to bring snack to the end of each game day. This may not seem like a huge contribution, but our athletes are hungry at the end of a game!
