UNIFORM BY-LAW

1. CLUB COLORS AND CREST/PATCH:

1.1 The designated Club uniform colors are Red, White and Blue as nominated and approved by the Club;

1.2 The approved Club Crest/Patch will be applied to all approved Club uniforms. The Club Crest/Patch will be emblazoned on the left breast of the shirt (in a manner considered to be over the heart of the player);

1.3 Any alteration of design requires approval by the Club;

1.4 Any reproduction of the club uniform or crest requires the approval by the majority of the Club's Executive Board.

1.5 All uniforms shall have player's numbers on the back of the jersey; in the interest of safety, no names shall be placed on team uniforms.

Coaching Staff Changes Policy

Any team that contemplates changes to its previously approved coaching roster, must send an email to the Board regarding the proposed addition(s), deletion(s), and/or change(s) for any and all coaches (i.e. head coach, assistant coaches) requesting approval of the Board regarding these changes.

Team Trainer Policy

Any team wanting to hire a trainer will request approval from the Board via an email indicating the trainer's status - non-volunteer (paid) or volunteer. The Board will need a copy of the trainer's state-issued pass and proof of insurance.

Coaching License Policy

The New Jersey Youth Soccer Coaching Schools program is designed to address the needs of the American player and coach. Currently, TCSA requires that coaches in the club continue their education and obtain licenses. The "F" and "E" courses are state (and/or national) level courses and are taught by the New Jersey Youth Soccer Coaching Schools Staff. TCSA reimburses coaches 100% for their F and E

license fees upon successful completion of the course and upon approval as a team rostered coach within the club.

The "F" Level Coaching License is the required license for all travel team coaches and is recommended by the state for coaching players 6-11 years old. TCSA requires all coaches in the club, including micro/rec. coaches to obtain this license;

The "E" Level Coaching License is the required TCSA policy for all full-sided travel team coaches and is recommended by the state for coaching players 11-14 years old. Every full-sided team should have a rostered E-Licensed Coach.
